

Isanti County Survey Results

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The community survey allows for engagement at the early stages of the planning process. The intent of the survey is to gather initial public feedback on likes, dislikes, and hopes for Isanti County. The survey was disseminated via an online engagement tool. Additionally, physical survey copies were made available for distribution.

Survey questions inquired on current opportunities and challenges for Isanti County, as well as desires and concerns for the future of the County. Participants were also given the opportunity to share demographic information; the demographic results are included at the end of this document. The survey questions touched on each of the six plan elements:

The survey consisted of 39 questions and was available from April 17 to May 30, with a total of approximately 333 responses.

Overall themes from the survey responses included the following topics: maintaining a rural community feel, growth and new development, a community center, taxes and affordability, and preserving farming and agriculture.

The term “**rural**” was used throughout many responses. This is a term that can have many definitions or contexts including: open space or larger acreage, small town / “country” feeling community, and less dense / less development.

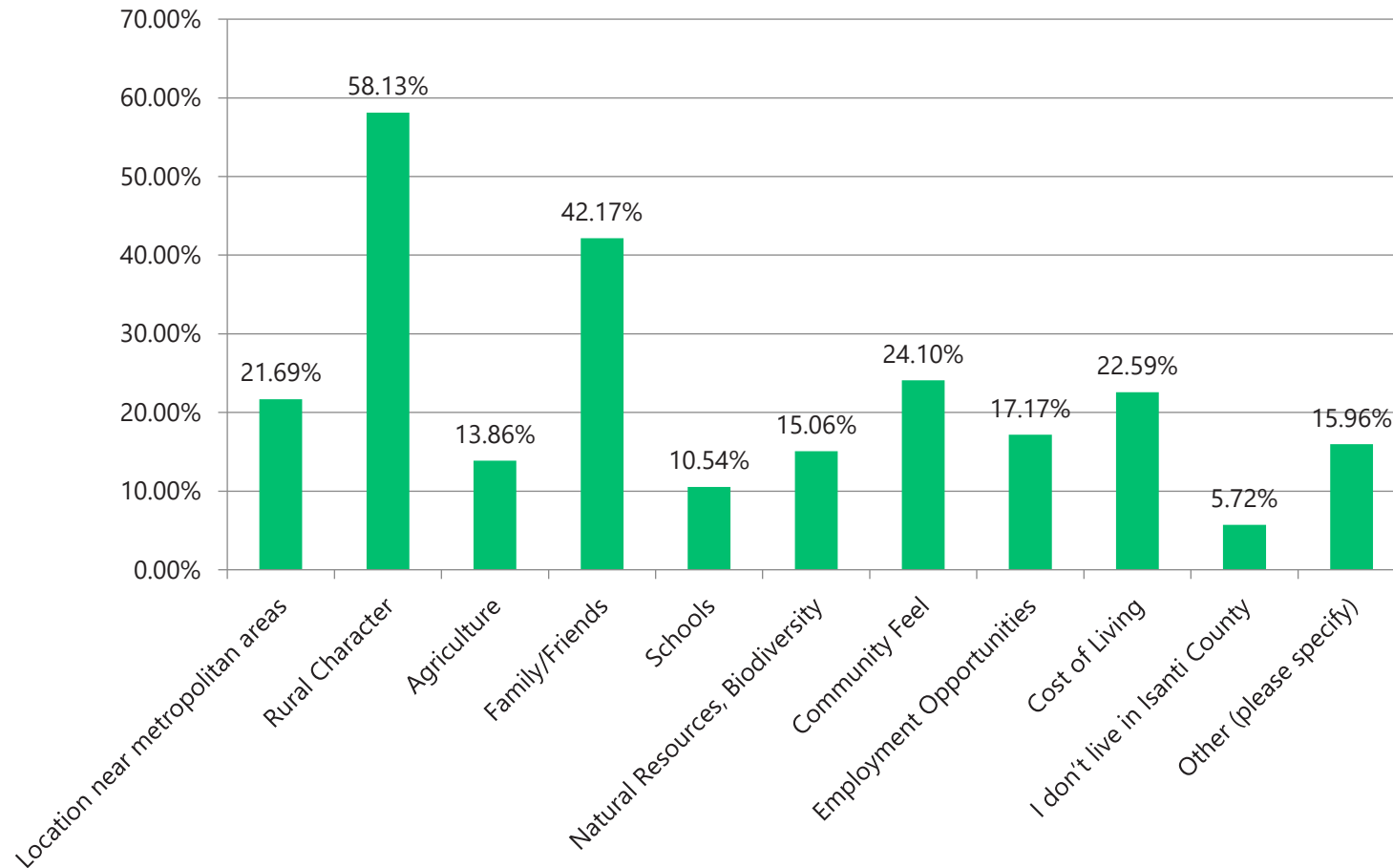
Recurring themes from the survey:

- The desire to maintain a “**small town**”, **rural** feel.
- Concerns for **new development and growth**.
- The desire for a **community center**.
- Concerns for the increasing **cost of living and taxes**.
- Emphasis on preserving and supporting existing and future **farming and agriculture**.

SURVEY RESPONSES AND DATA

QUESTION 1) WHY DID YOU CHOOSE TO LIVE IN ISANTI COUNTY? (SELECT ALL THAT APPLY)

Many respondents noted they chose to live in Isanti County because of the rural character, or family/ friends. Other responses noted recreation and natural resources, and the family-friendly feel of the community.



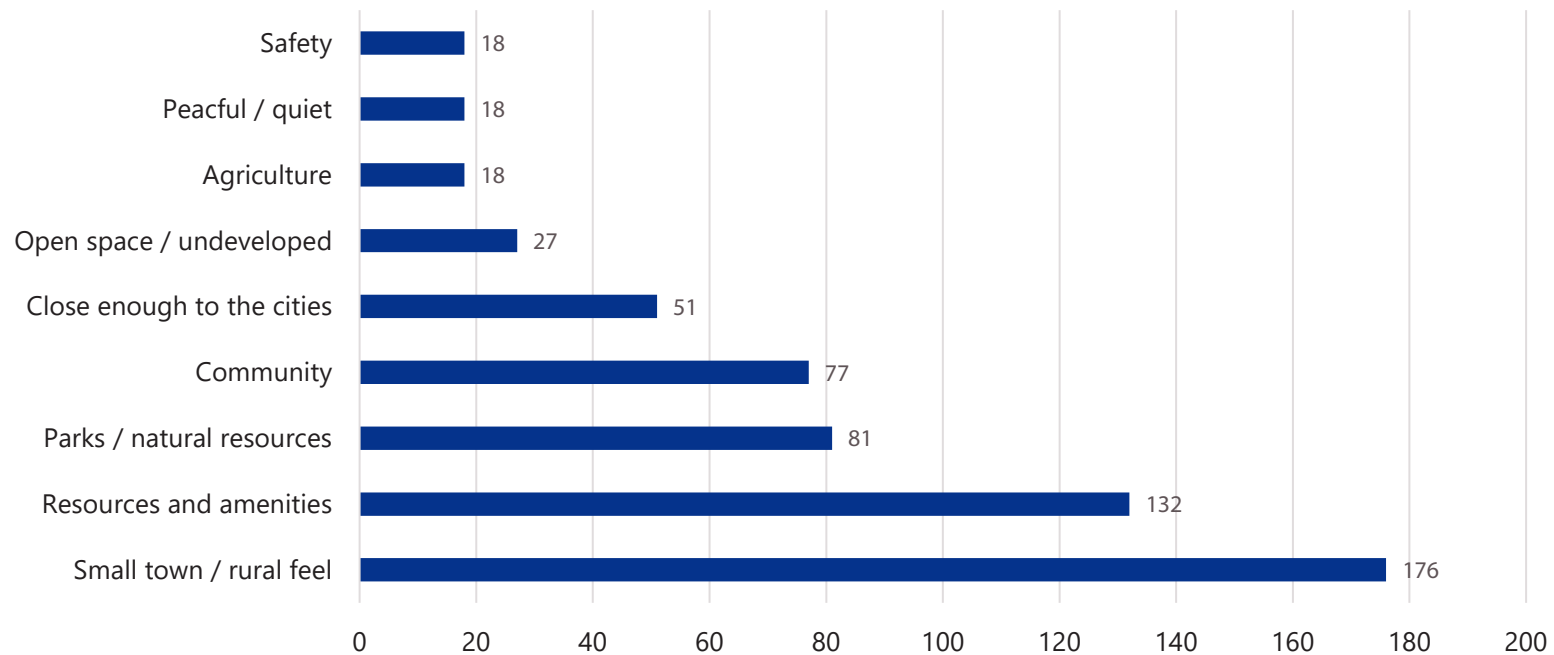
QUESTION 2) WHAT ARE THE TWO THINGS YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT ISANTI COUNTY?

This question was an open comment box with the opportunity to list the two things respondents liked most. The top themes that emerged across responses are identified in the graph below.

The most common response was that people liked the small town or rural feel of Isanti County. This included responses that mentioned a “country-feel”.

The second most common response was about resources and amenities, most commonly referring to retail (or “big box stores”), including the food co-op and restaurants.

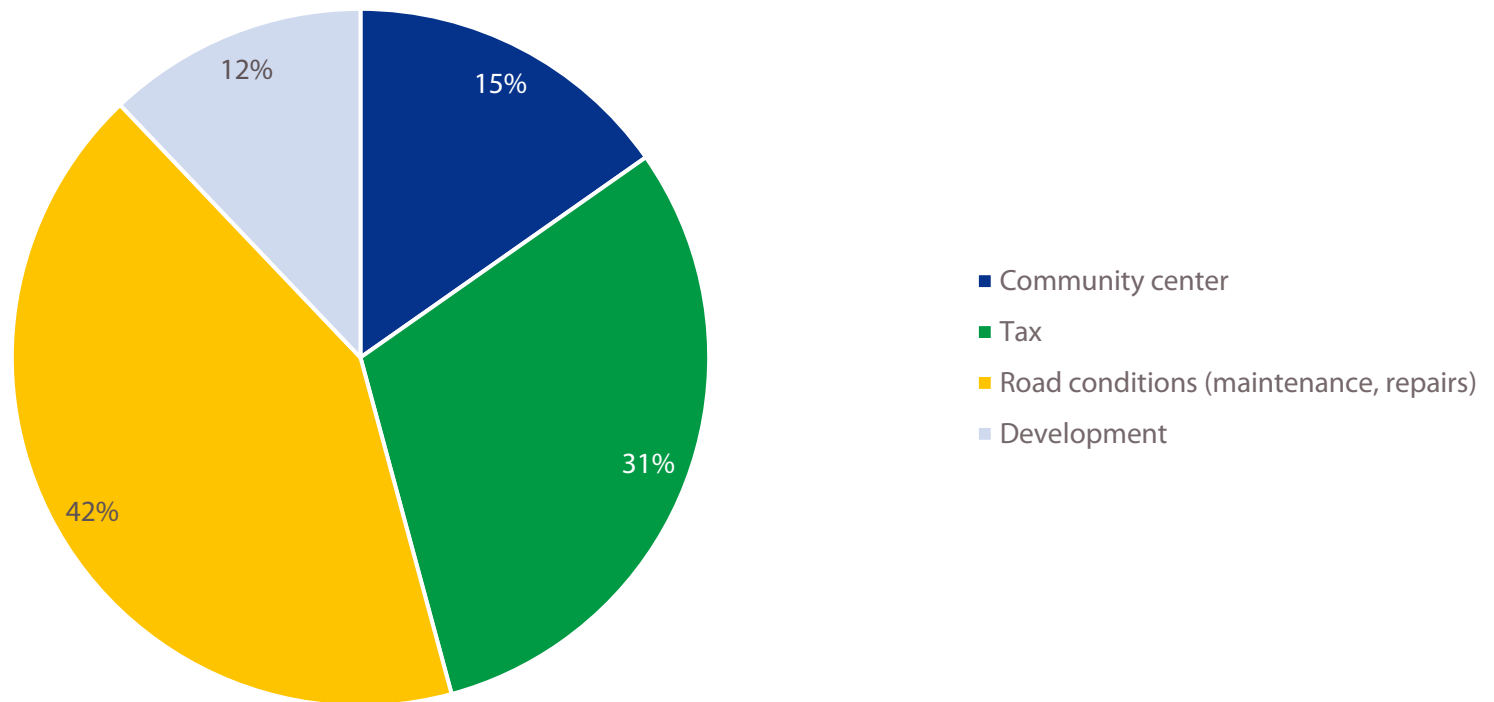
The third most common response was in appreciation for the parks and natural resources in the County, for example: county parks, wildlife areas, and outdoor activities like kayaking.



QUESTION 3) WHAT ARE TWO THINGS YOU WOULD CHANGE THAT WOULD IMPROVE DAY-TO-DAY LIFE IN ISANTI COUNTY?

This question was an open comment box with the opportunity to list the two things respondents would change to improve day-to-day life. The top themes that emerged across responses are identified in the graph below.

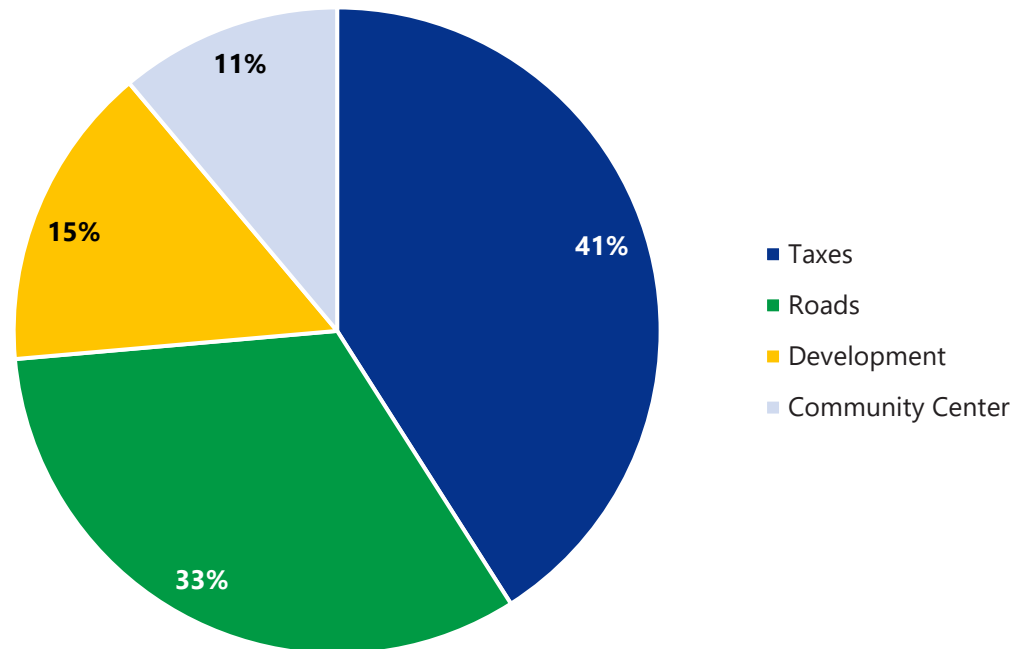
Approximately 42% of responses indicated that they would change the road maintenance and improve road conditions. 31% indicated that they would like to decrease taxes (specifically property taxes).



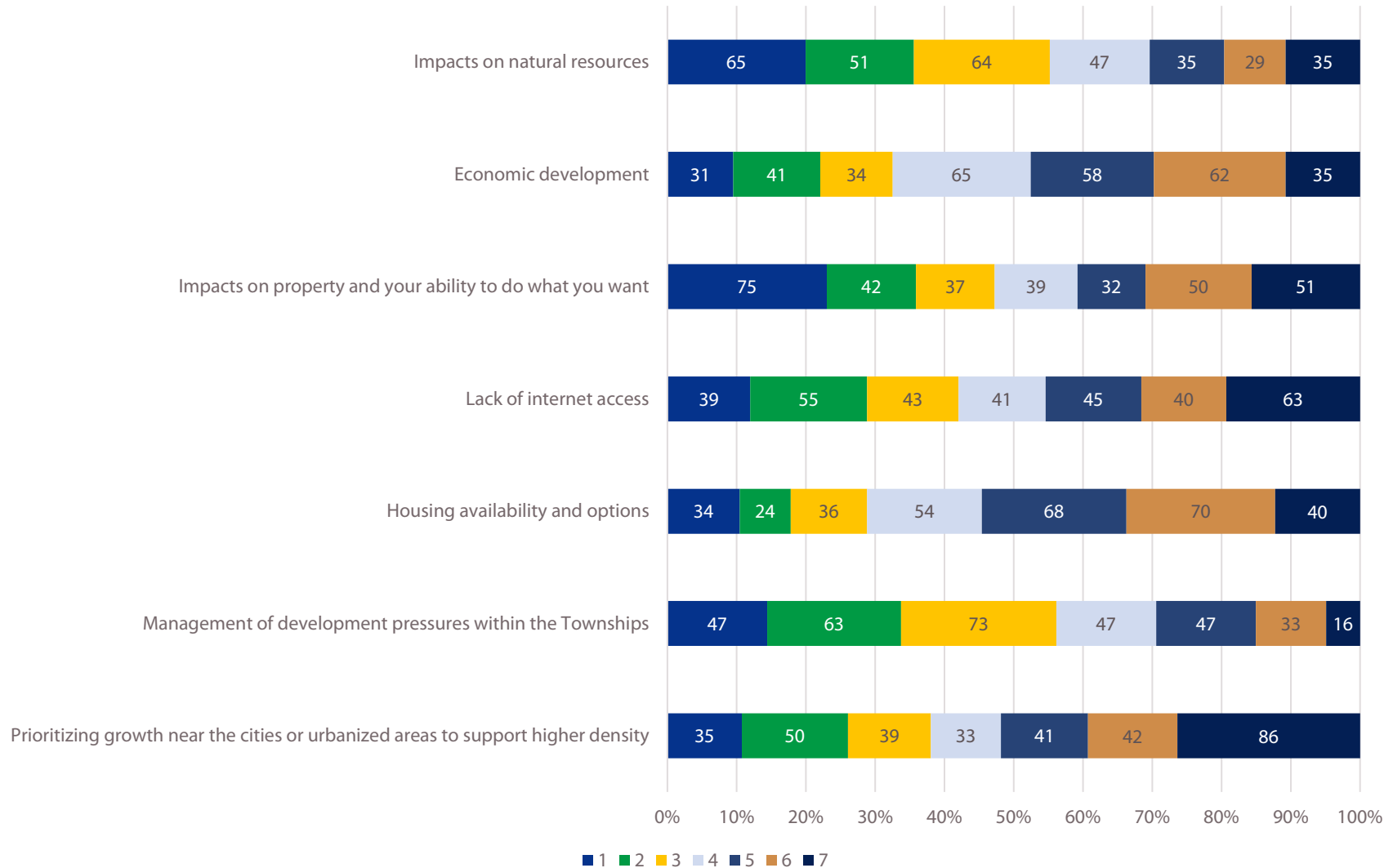
QUESTION 4) WHAT IS THE BIGGEST CHALLENGE THAT ISANTI COUNTY RESIDENTS WILL FACE OVER THE NEXT 20 YEARS?

This question included an open comment box for respondents to identify the biggest challenge they perceived.

Like to Question 3, responses focused on roadway maintenance, lowering taxes, monitoring / decreasing development, and the need for a community center.

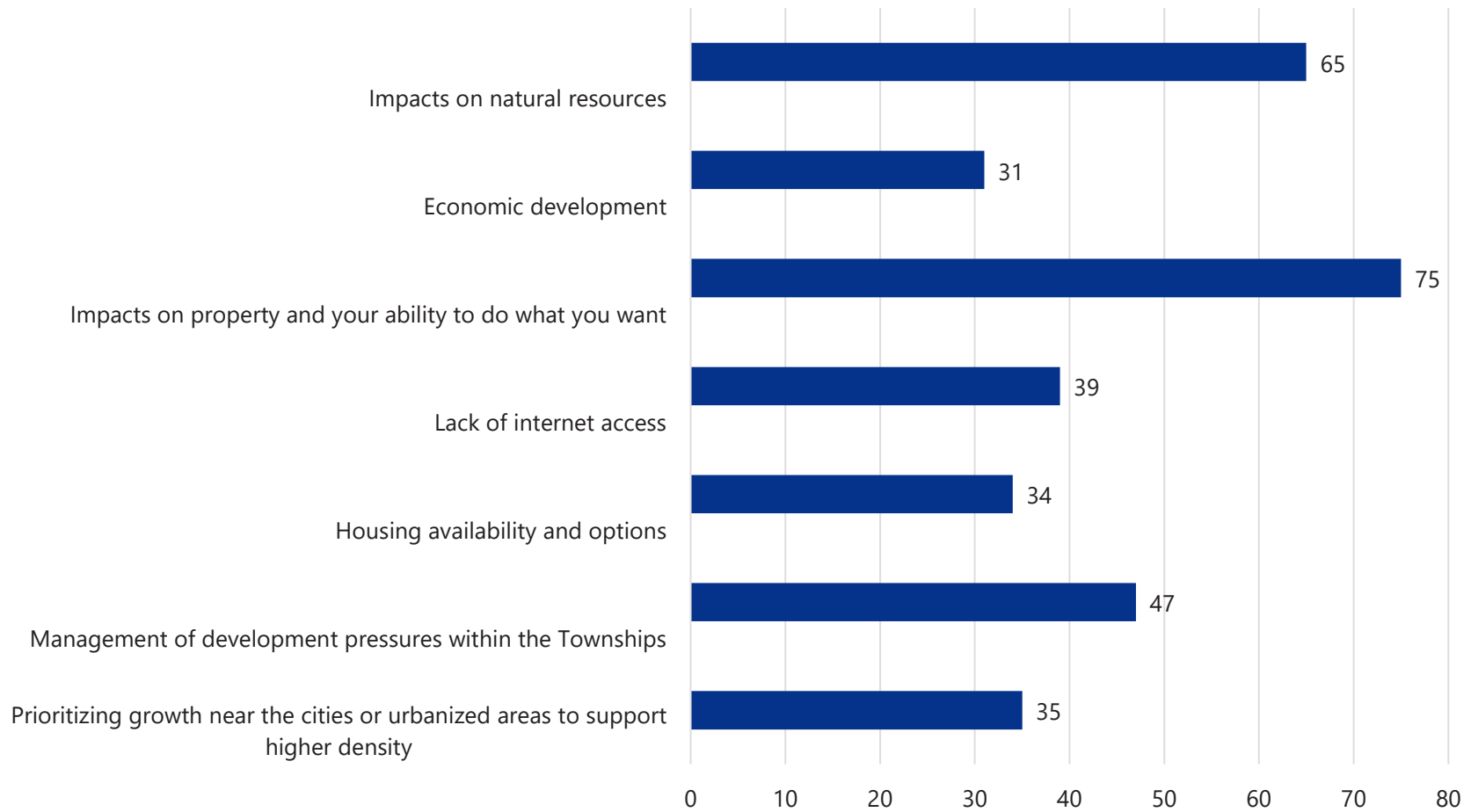

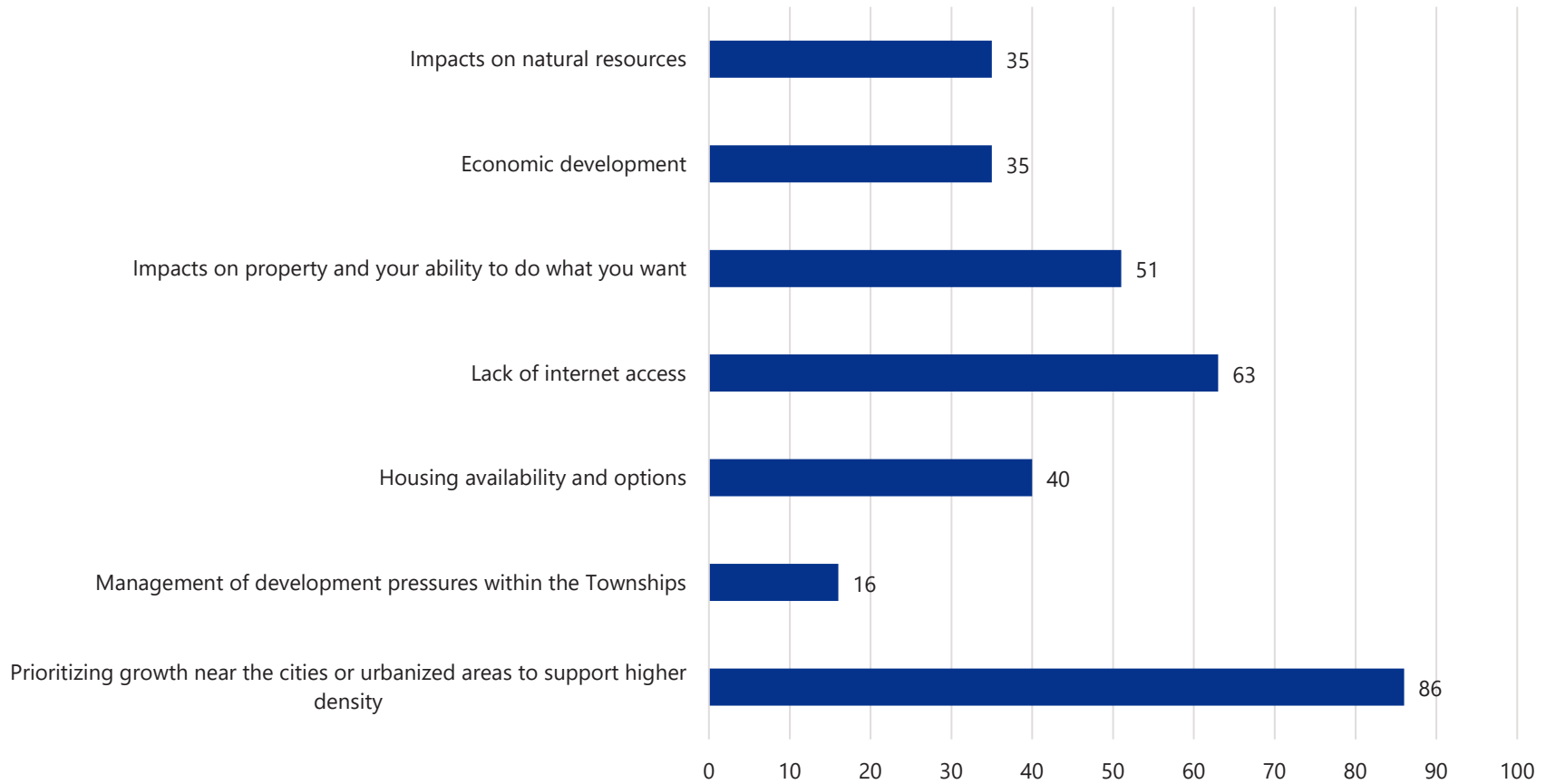
Highest Priority

The highest priority identified for the future of Isanti County was impacts on property and people's ability to do what they want. The second highest priority identified was impacts on natural resources.

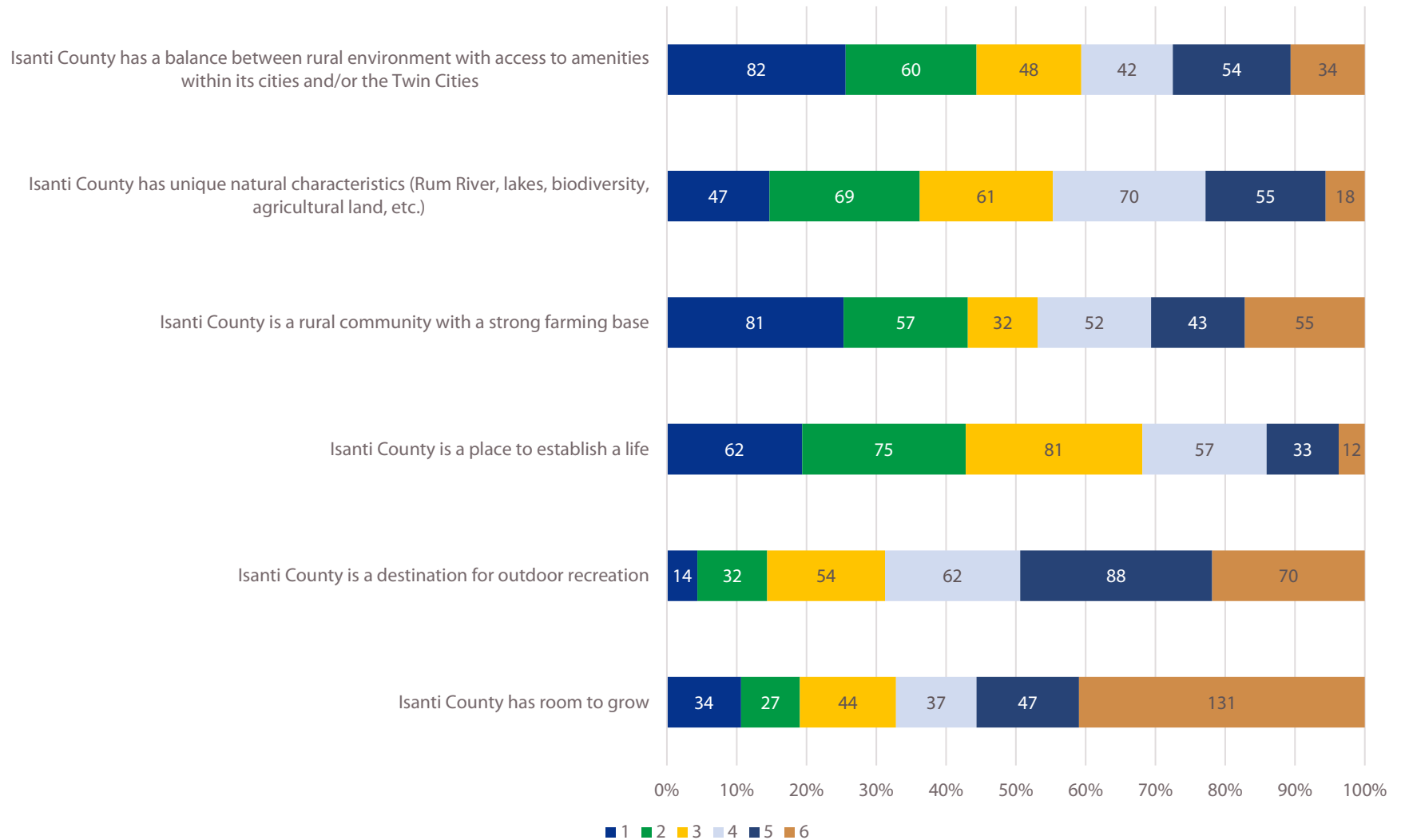


Lowest Priority

The lowest priority identified for the future of Isanti County was prioritizing growth near the cities or urbanized areas to support higher density. The second lowest priority identified was lack of internet access.



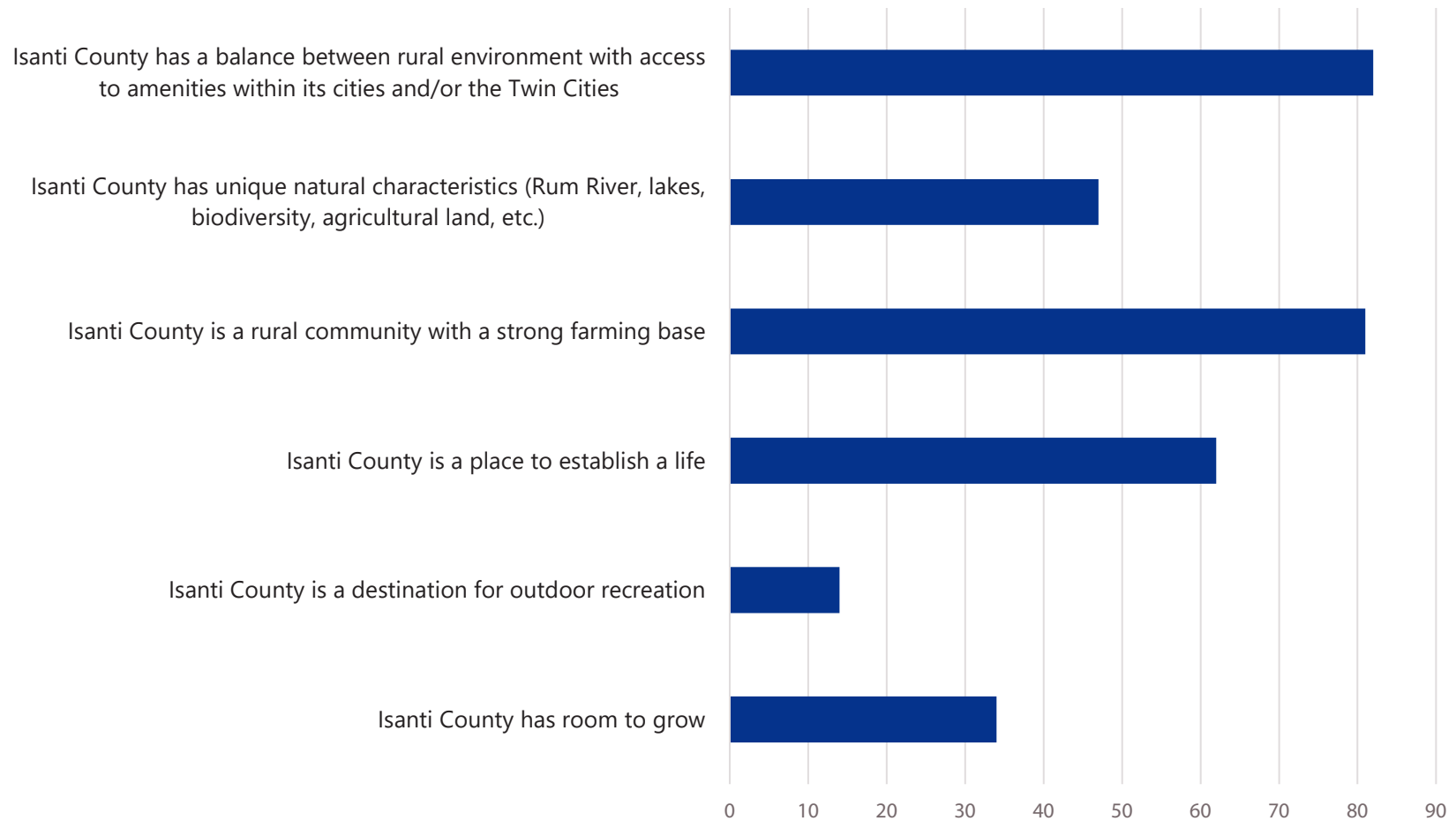

Most Reflective

The description that was chosen as the most reflective was “Isanti County has a balance between rural environment with access to amenities within its cities and/or the Twin Cities.”

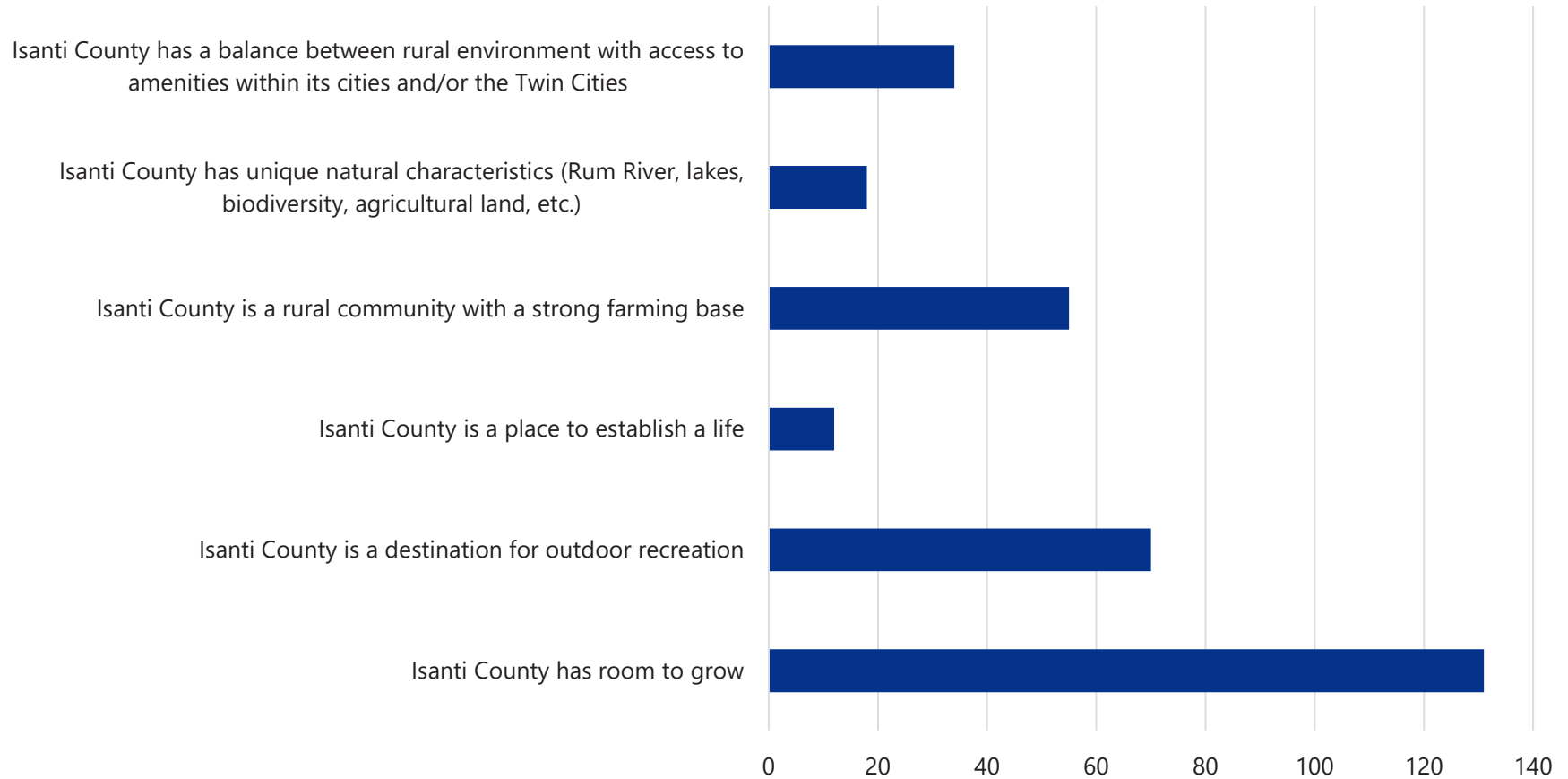
The second most reflective description was “Isanti County is a rural community with a strong farming base.”



Least Reflective

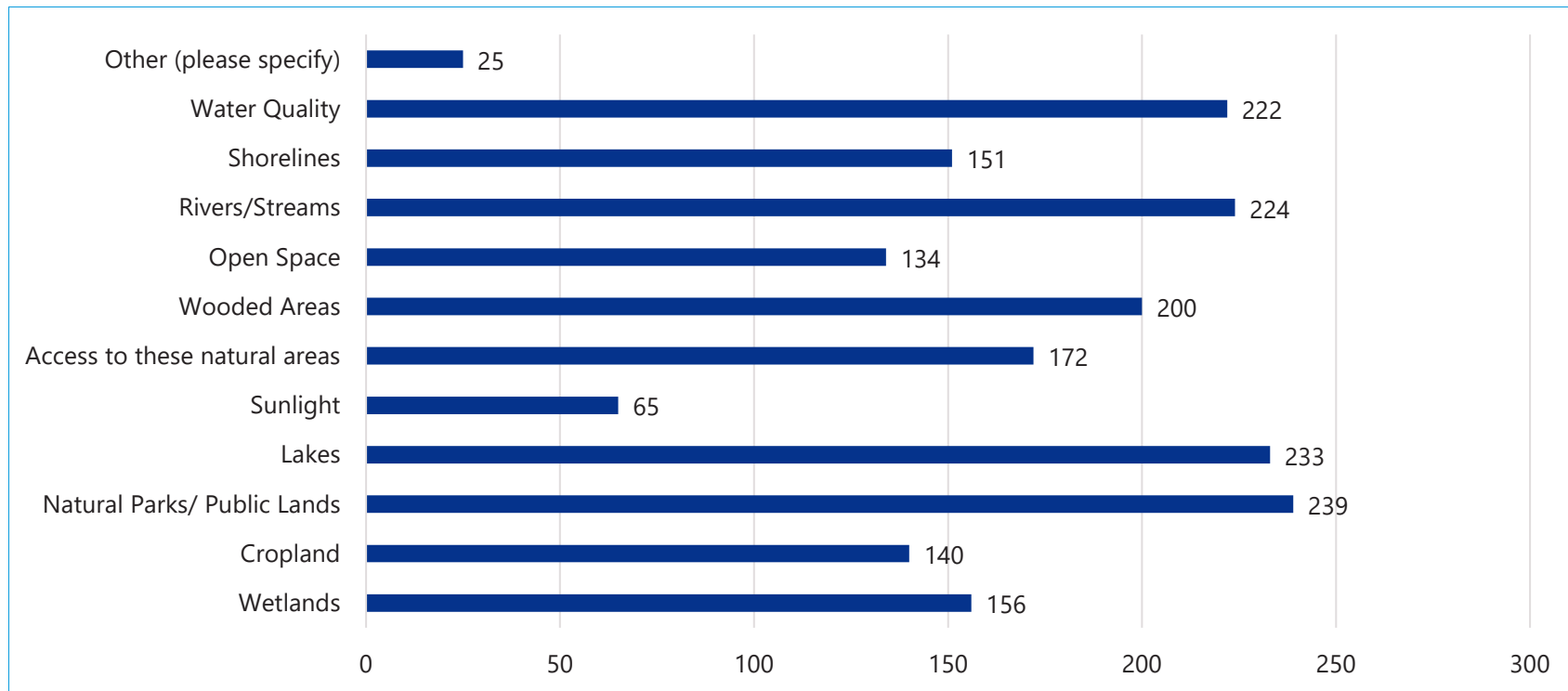
The description that was chosen as the least reflective was "Isanti County has room to grow."

The top choices included natural parks / public lands (73%), lakes (71%), rivers/ streams (68%), and water quality (68%).



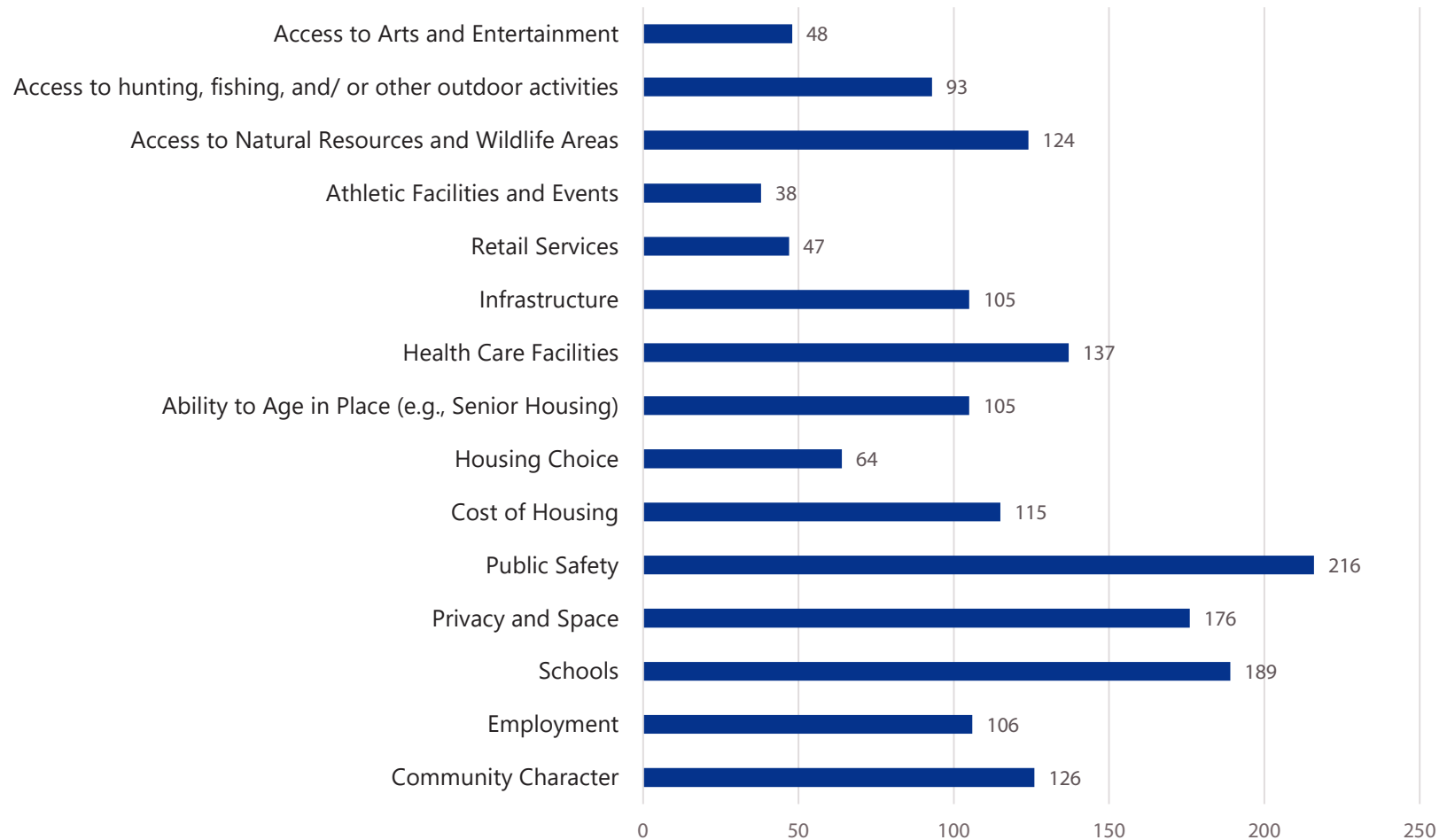
Write-in responses included the following:

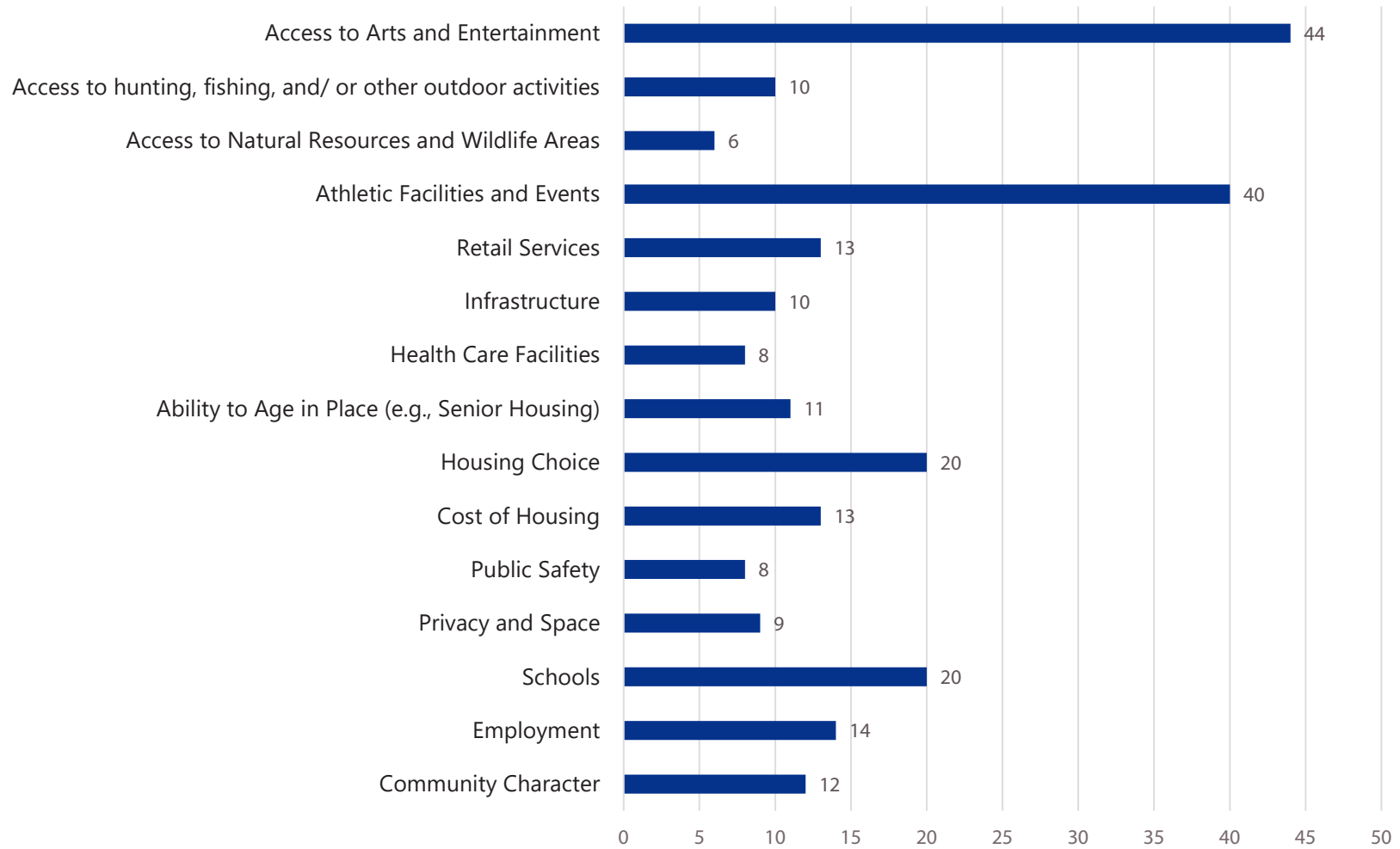
Most Important

Least Important

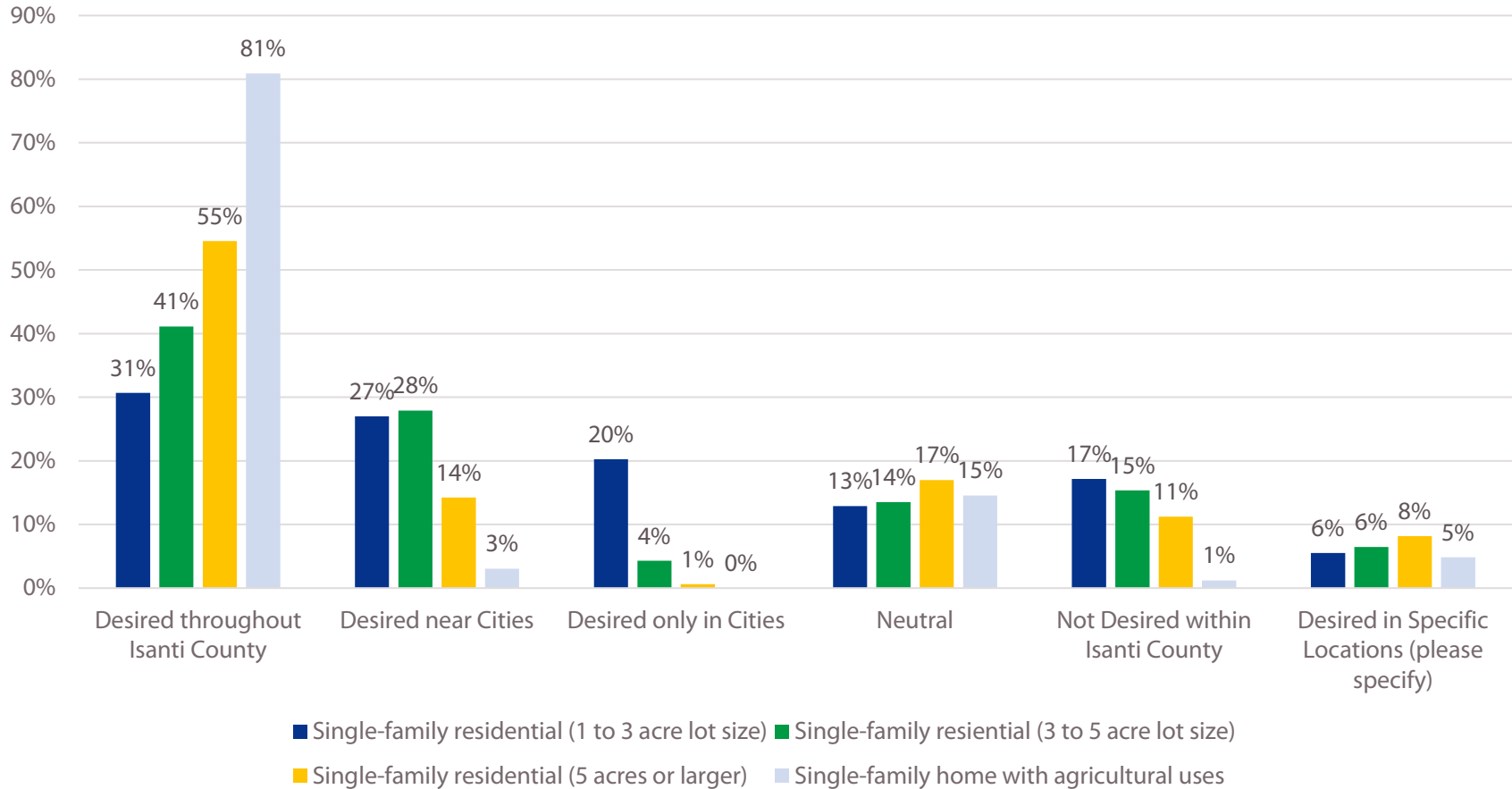
The least important resources were access to arts and entertainment, and athletic facilities and events.



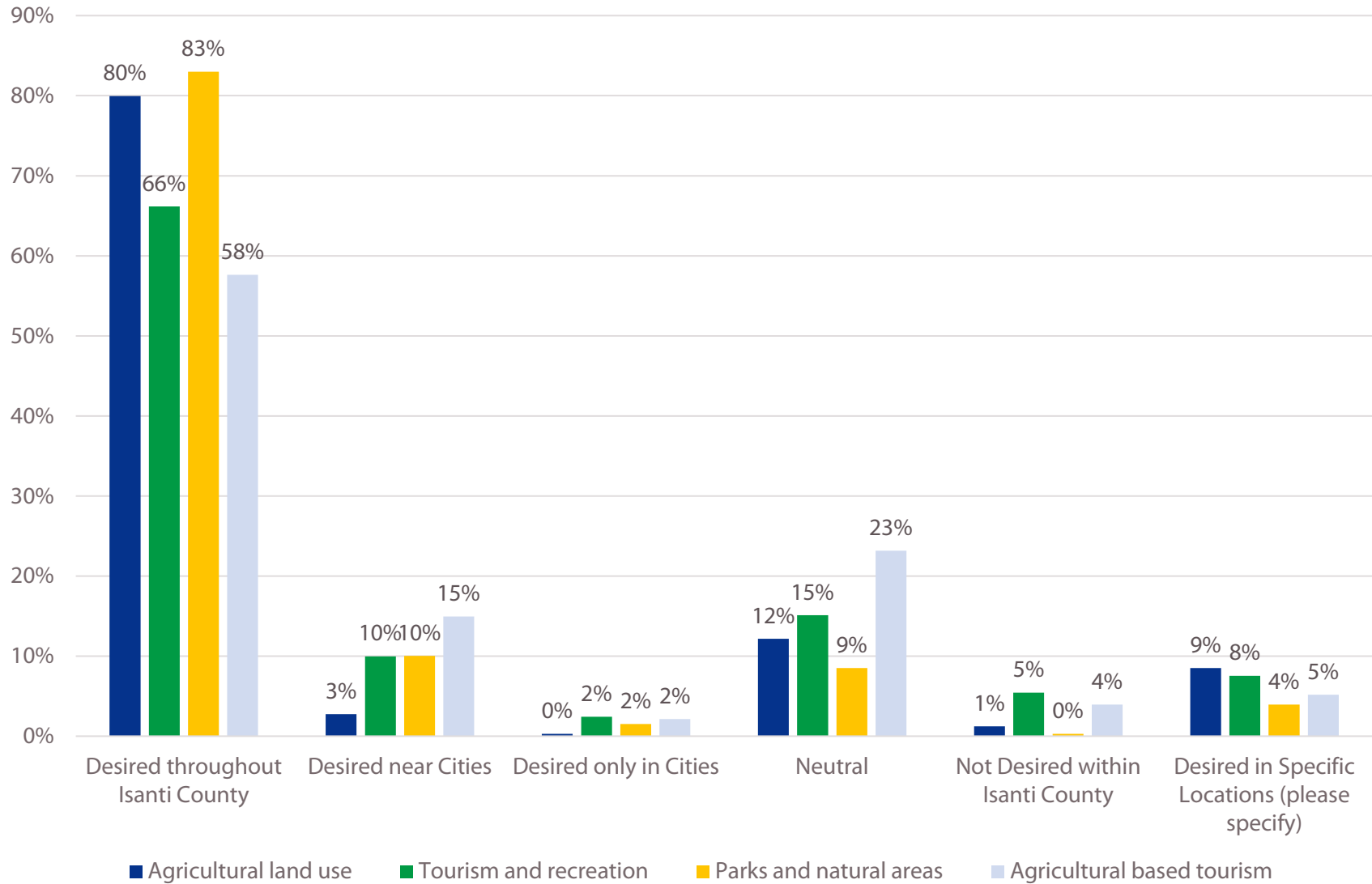
LAND USE QUESTIONS:

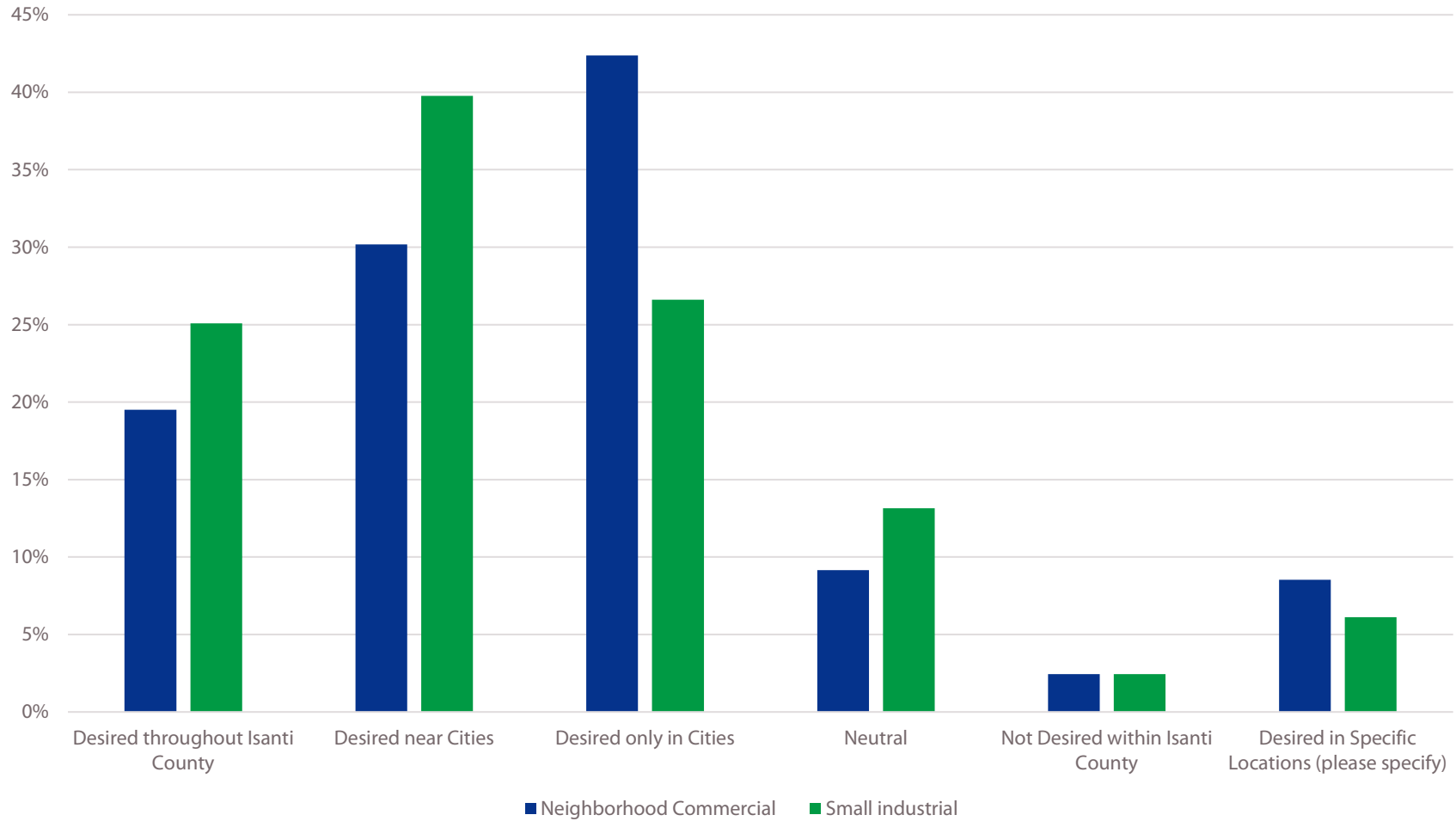
Residential Land Uses



Agricultural/Open Space Uses

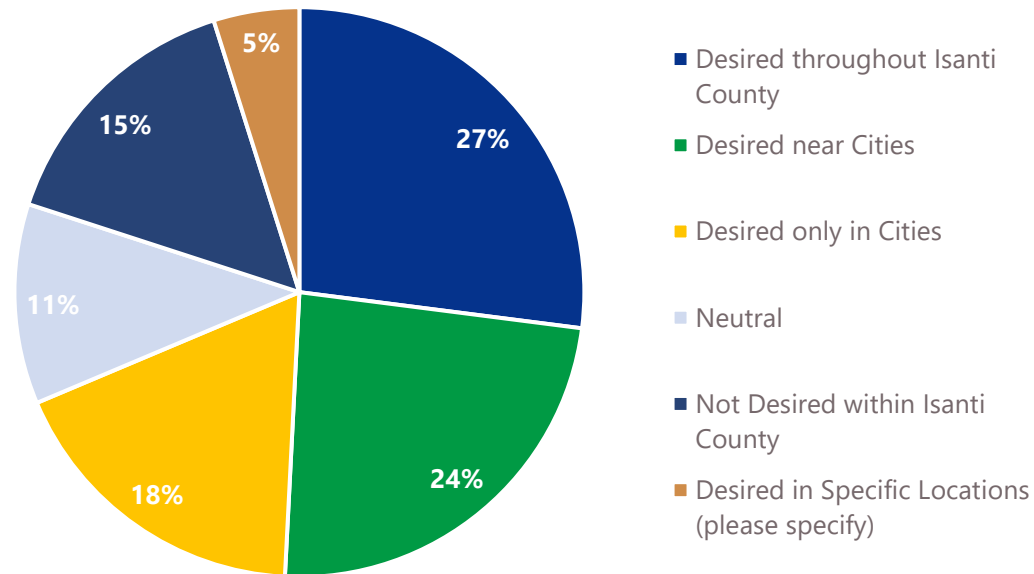


Commercial/Industrial Uses



QUESTION 9) WHERE SHOULD SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (1 TO 3 ACRE LOT SIZE) DEVELOPMENT OCCUR IN ISANTI COUNTY?

The top responses had the desire to see single-family residential (1 to 3 acre lot size) throughout the county (27%), and near cities (24%).

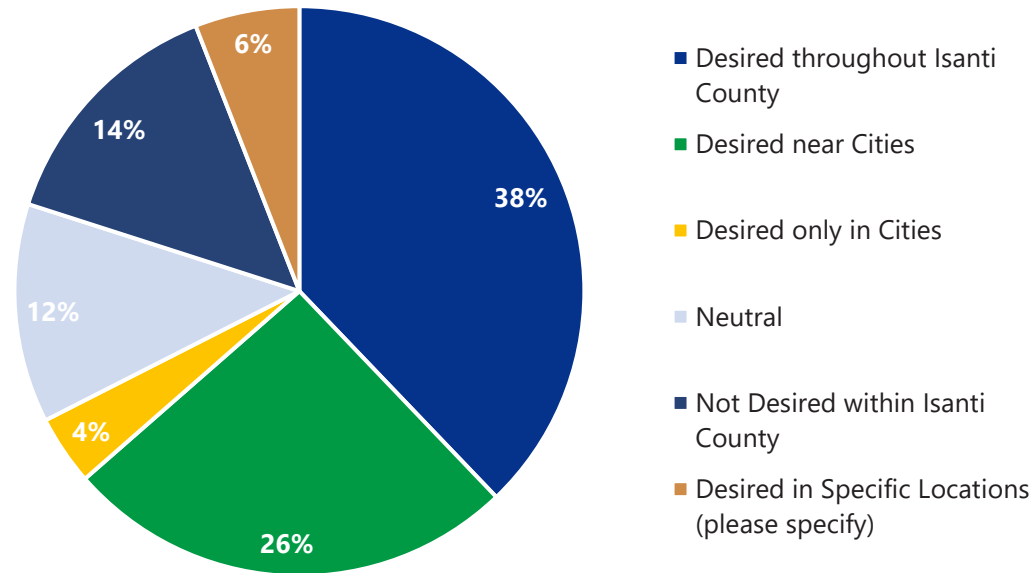


Write-in responses included the desire to see single-family residential (1 to 3 acre lot size)

- Near primary traffic routes
- A few miles outside of city limits
- In already developed areas / not in rural areas

QUESTION 10) WHERE SHOULD SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (3 TO 5 ACRE LOT SIZE) DEVELOPMENT OCCUR IN ISANTI COUNTY?

The top responses had the desire to see single-family residential (3 to 5 acre lot size) throughout the county (38%), and near cities (26%).

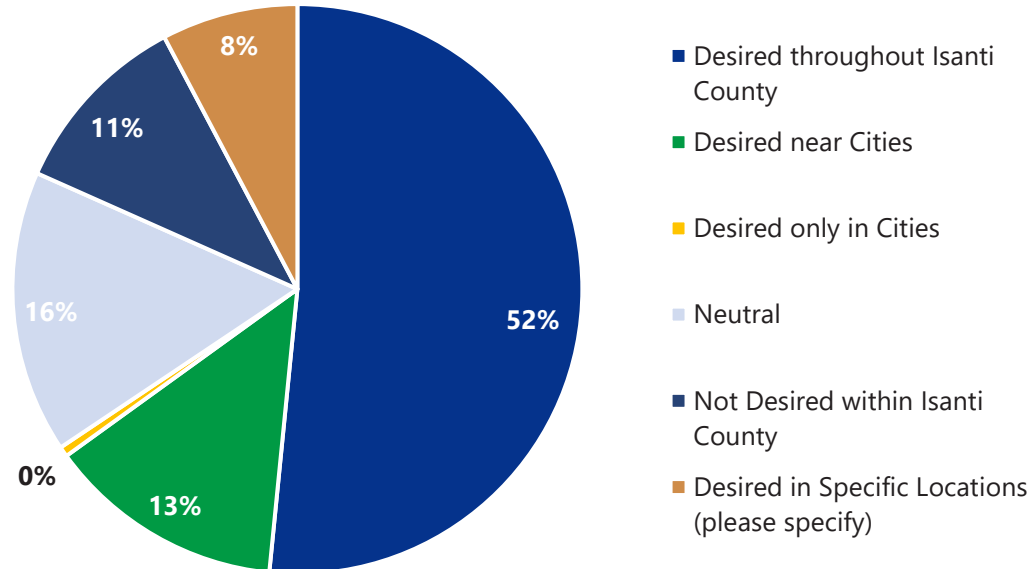


Write-in responses included the desire to see single-family residential (3 to 5 acre lot size)...

The top responses had the desire to see single-family residential (5 acre or larger lot size) throughout the county (52%).

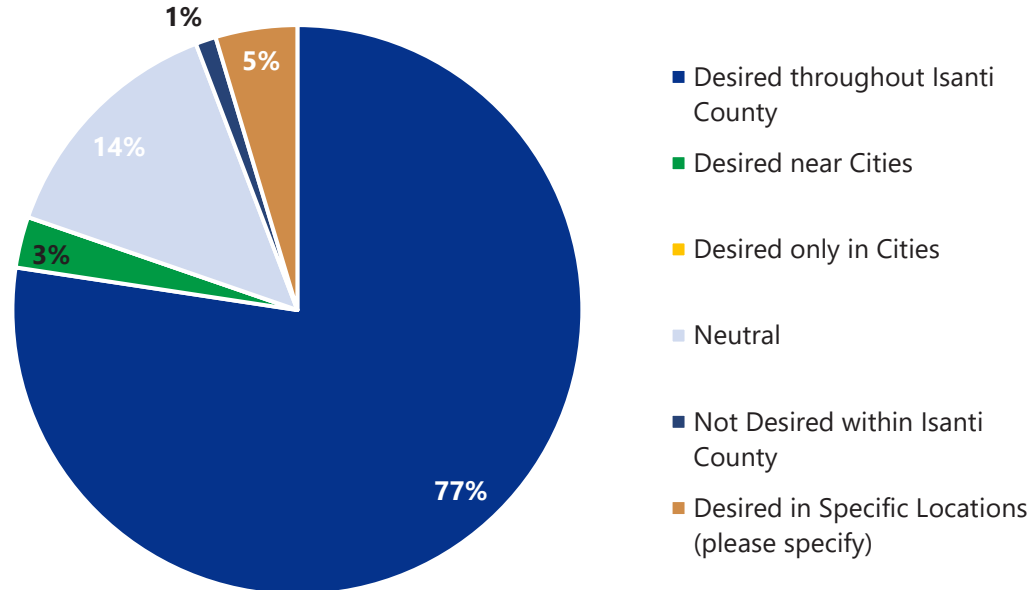


Write-in responses included the desire to see single-family residential (5 acre or larger) lot size) in...

The top responses had the desire to see single-family homes with agricultural uses throughout the county (77%).

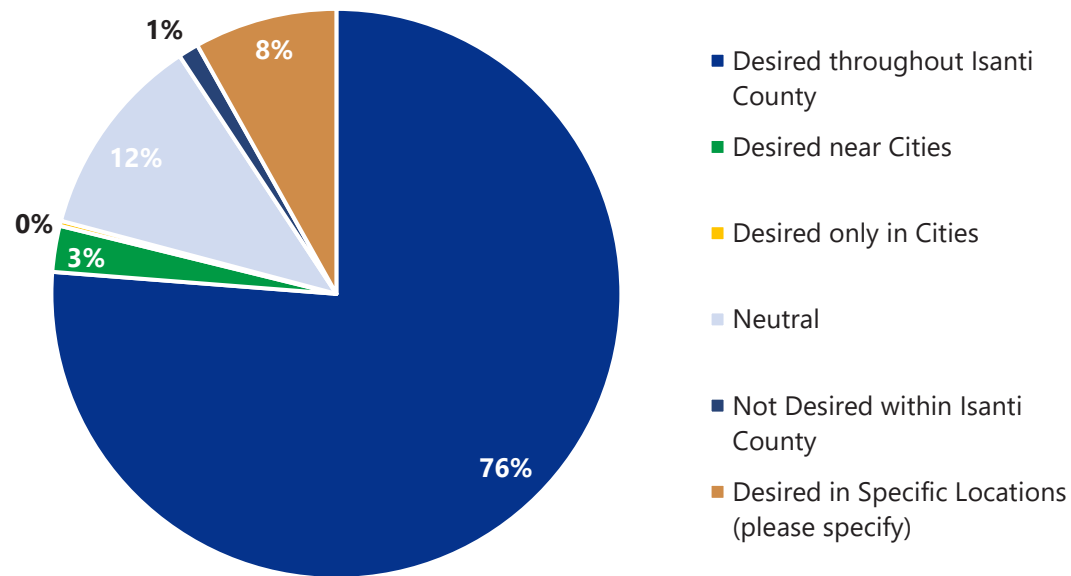


Write-in responses included the desire to see single-family homes with agricultural uses in...

The top responses had the desire to see agricultural land use throughout the county (76%).

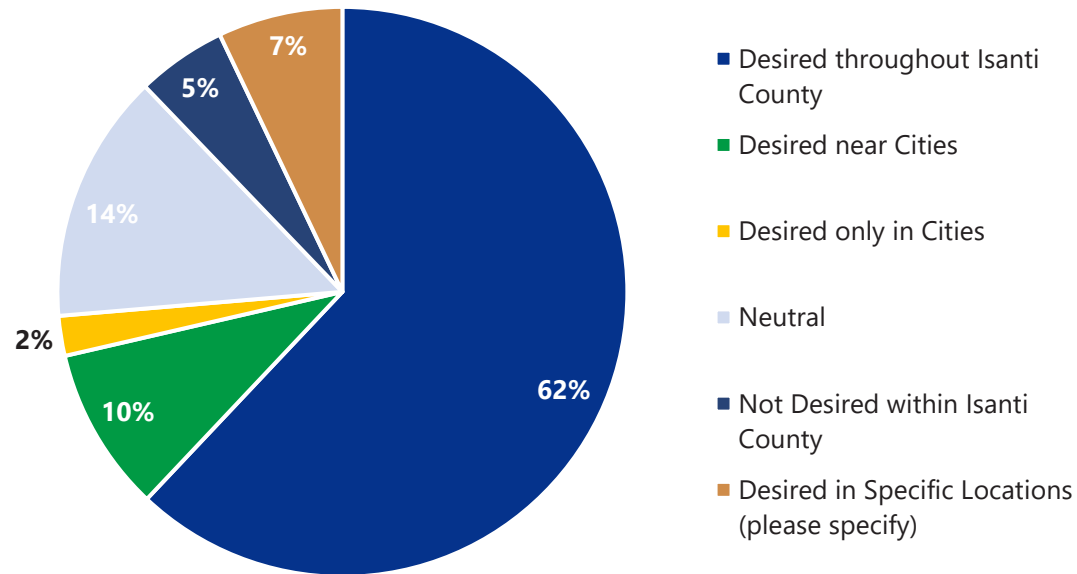


Write-in responses included the desire to see agricultural land use...

The top responses had the desire to see tourism and recreation throughout the county (62%).

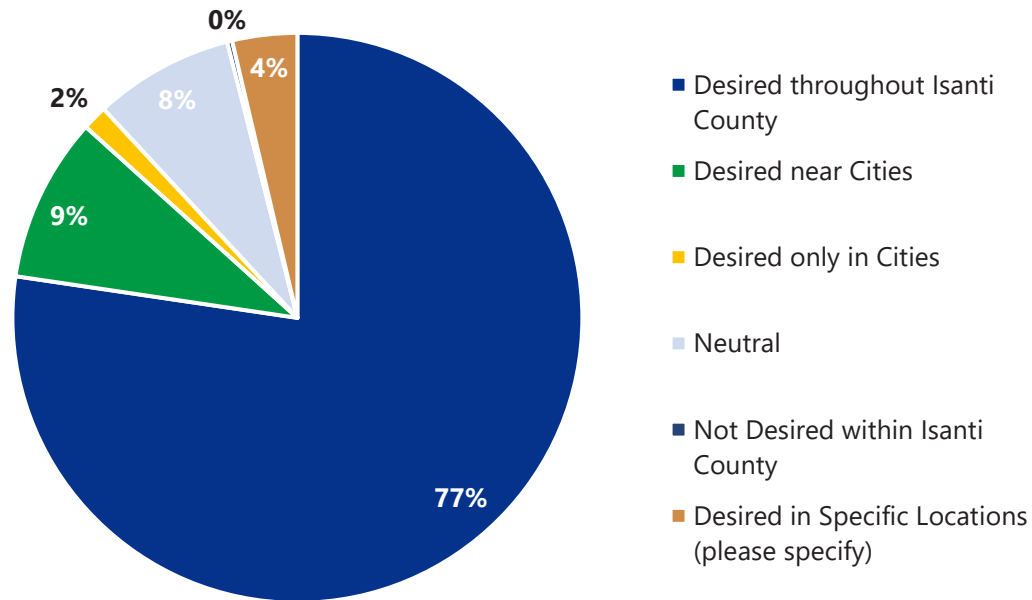


Write-in responses included the desire to see tourism and recreation in...

The top responses had the desire to see parks and natural resources throughout the county (62%).

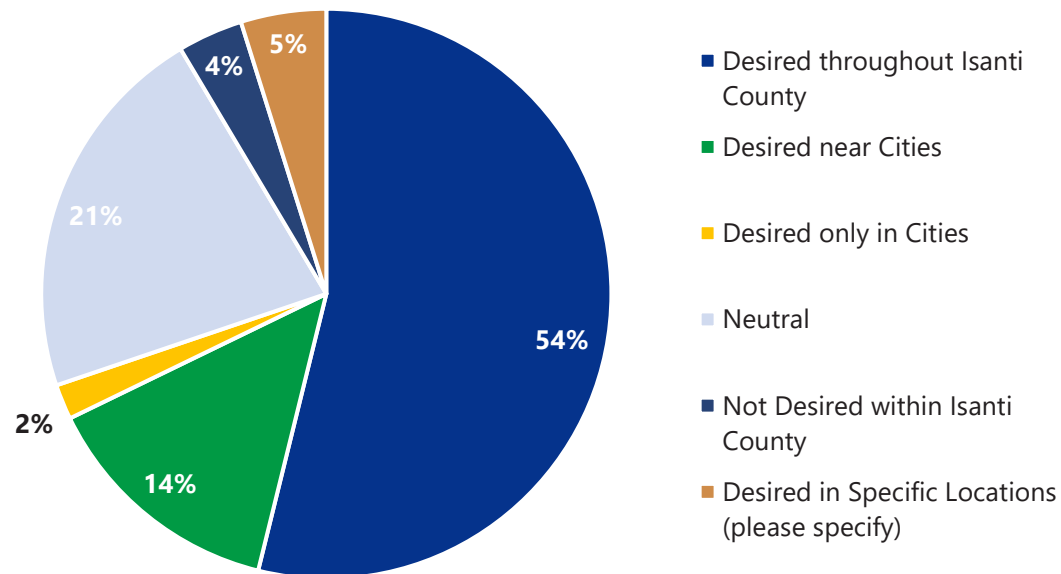


Write-in responses included the desire to see parks and natural resources in...

The top responses had the desire to see agricultural based tourism throughout the county (54%).

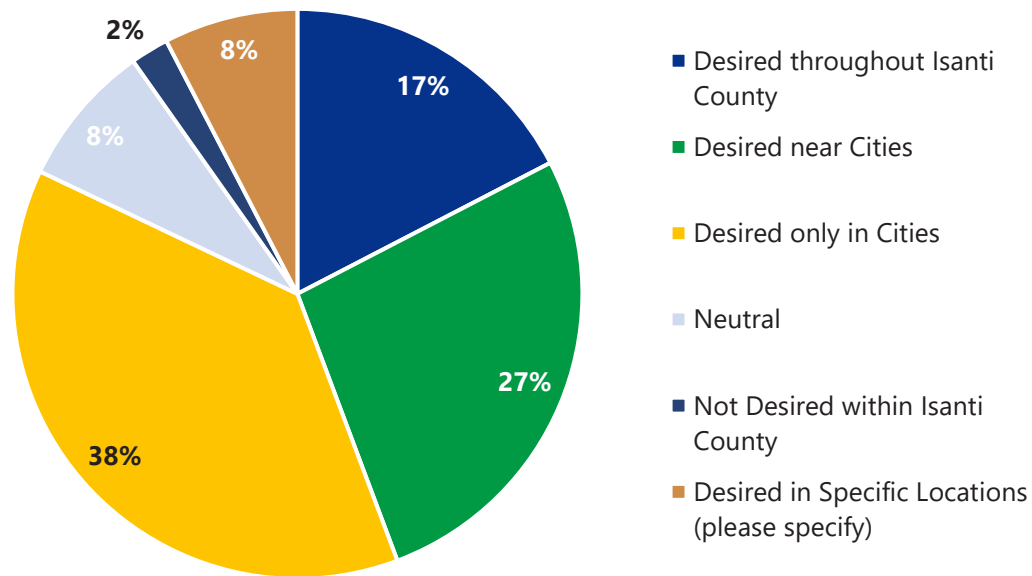


Write-in responses included the desire to see agricultural based tourism...

The top responses had the desire to see neighborhood commercial development only in cities (38%).

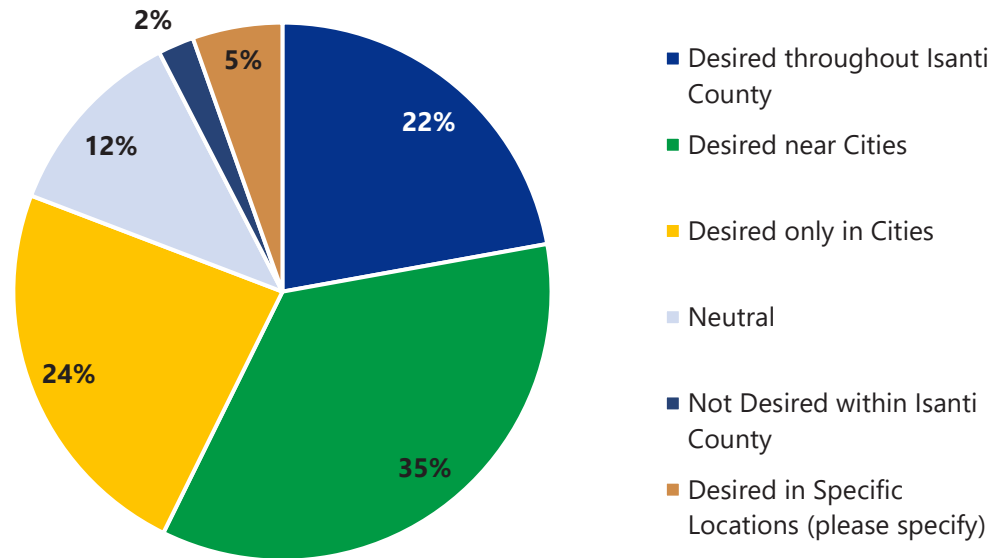


Write-in responses included the desire to see neighborhood commercial development...

The top responses had the desire to see small industrial use development near cities (35%).

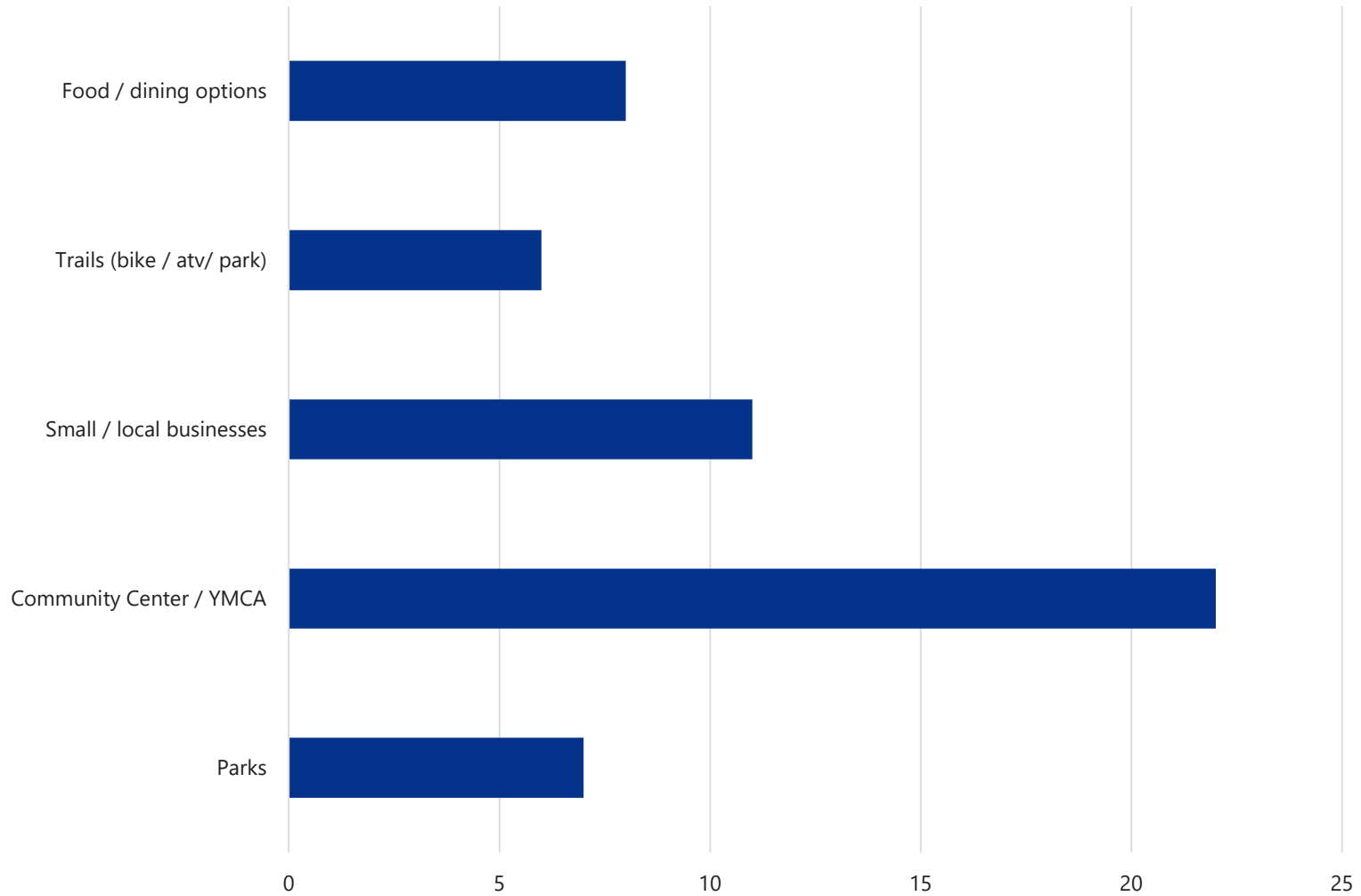


Write-in responses included the desire to see small industrial use development...

- Not near waterways

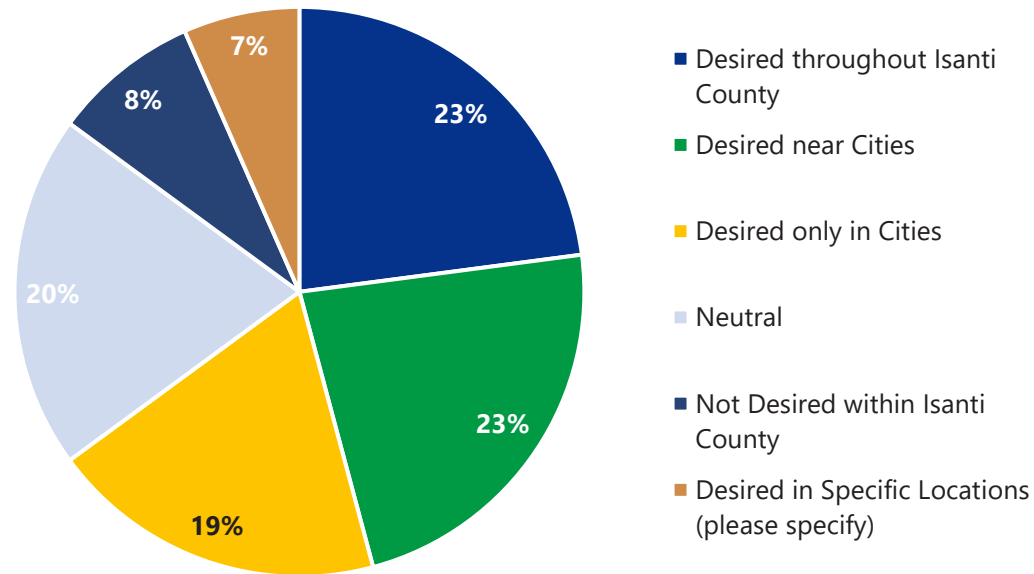
QUESTION 19) WHAT OTHER TYPE OF DEVELOPMENT SHOULD OCCUR IN ISANTI COUNTY?

Most responses desired other development to occur throughout the county (23%) or near cities (23%).

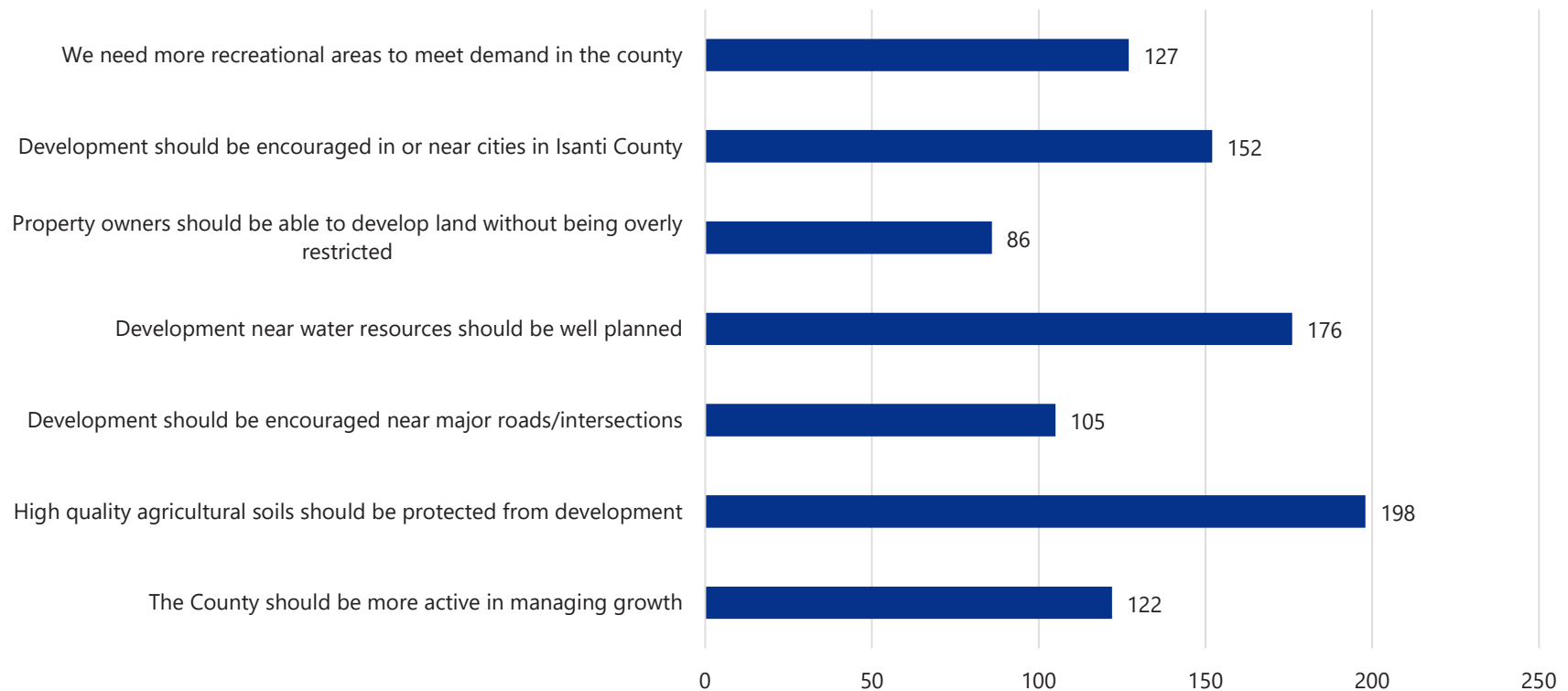


Write-in responses included the desire to see other development...

Most responses thought that high quality agricultural soils should be protected from development, and development near water resources should be well planned.



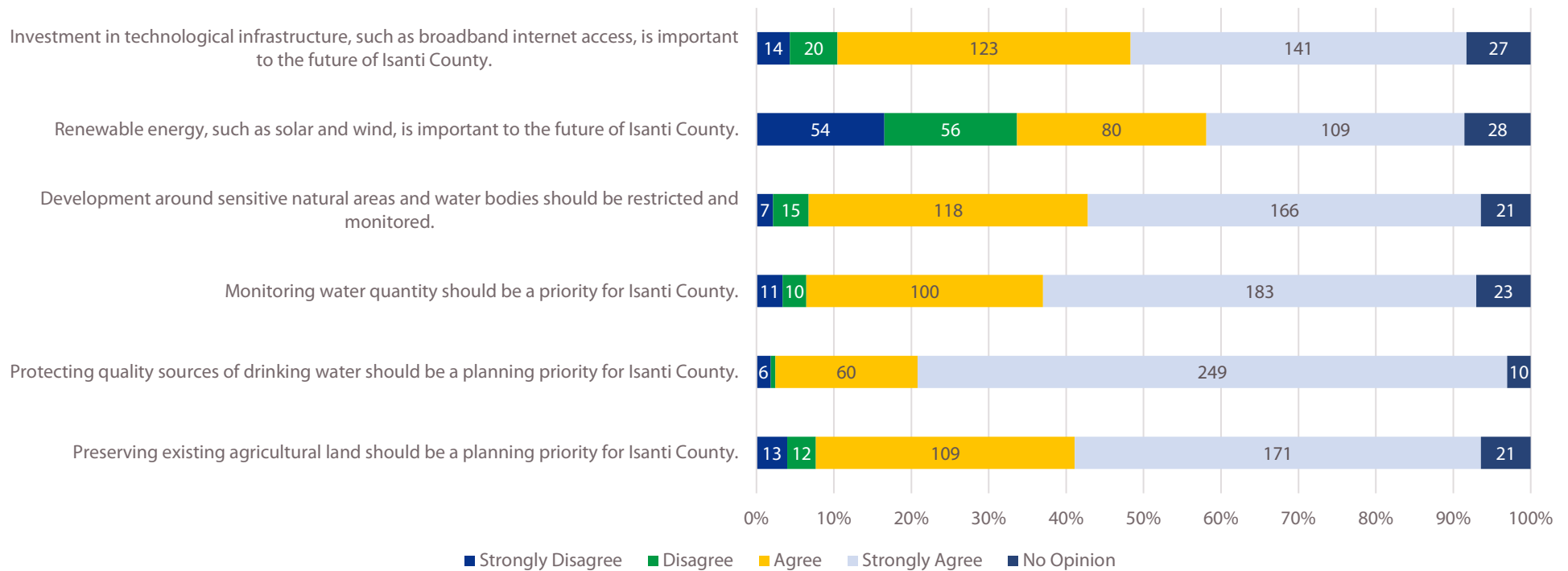
QUESTION 22) RATE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS

Respondents rated the following statements (strongly disagree to strongly agree):

- Preserving existing agricultural land should be a planning priority for Isanti County.
- Protecting quality sources of drinking water should be a planning priority for Isanti County.
- Monitoring water quantity should be a priority for Isanti County.
- Development around sensitive natural areas and water bodies should be restricted and monitored.
- Renewable energy, such as solar and wind, is important to the future of Isanti County.
- Investment in technological infrastructure, such as broadband internet access, is important to the future of Isanti County.

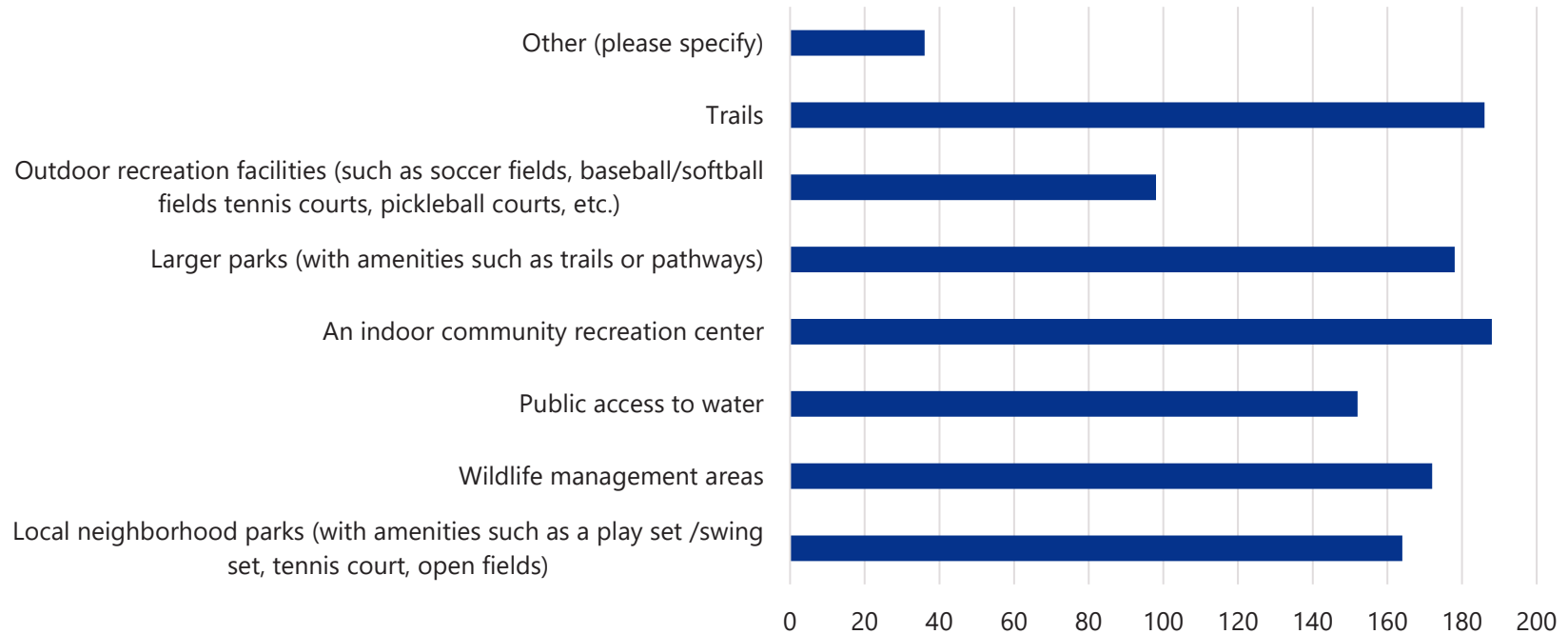
The top rated response was "Protecting quality sources of drinking water should be a planning priority for Isanti County."

Top responses included trails, an indoor community recreation center, and larger parks (with amenities such as trails or pathways).



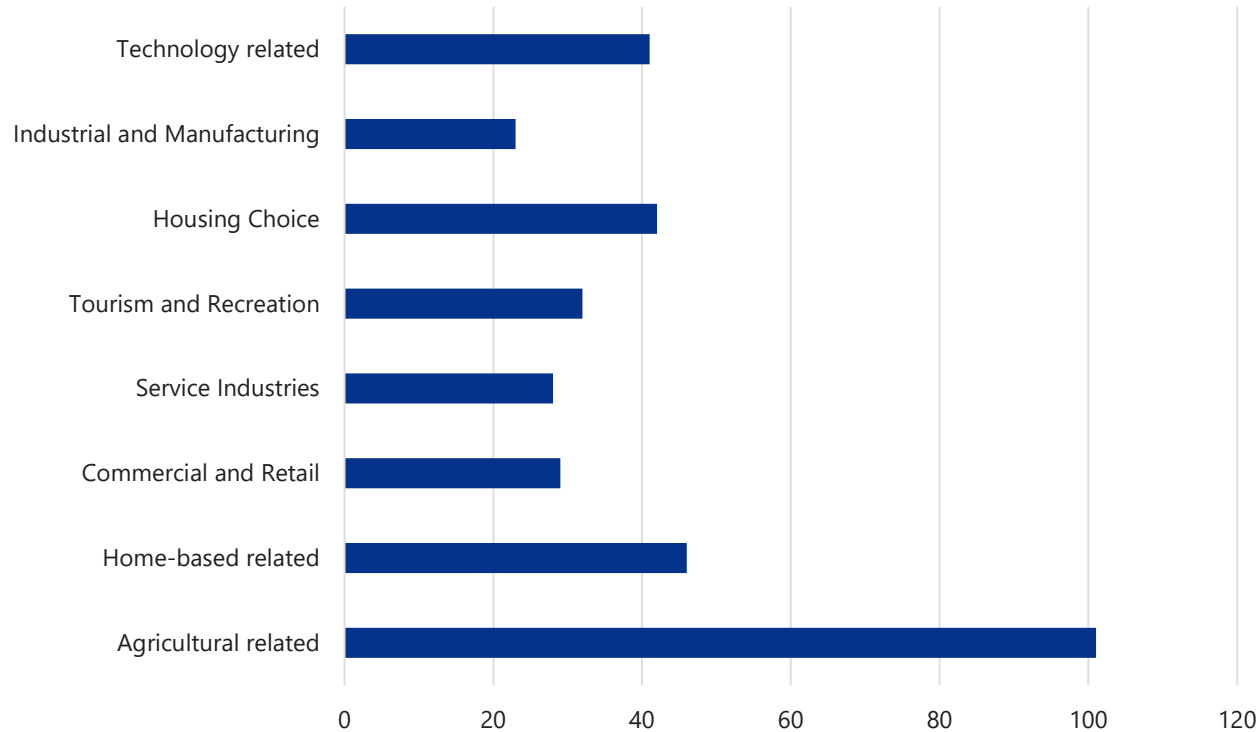
Write-in responses included the following:

- Bike trails

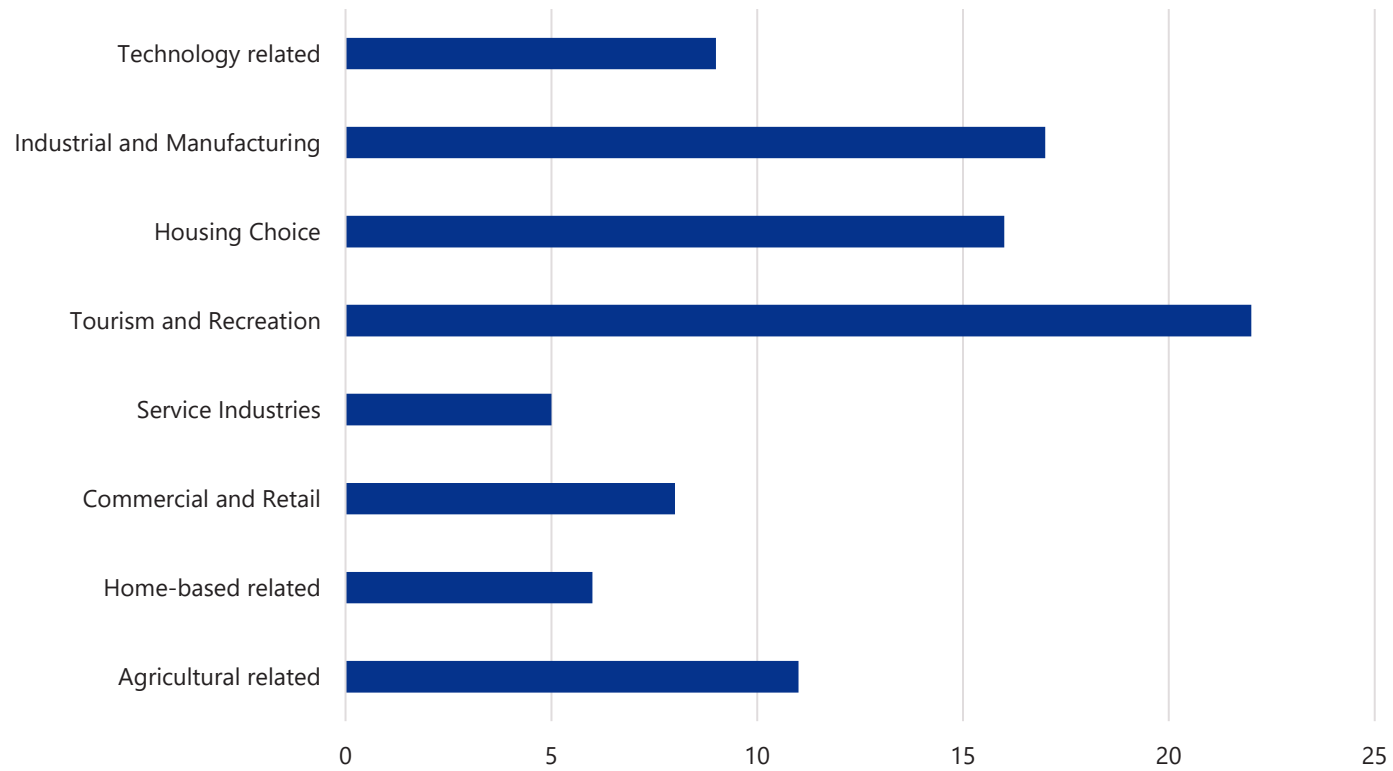

“Very Important” Ranked Resources

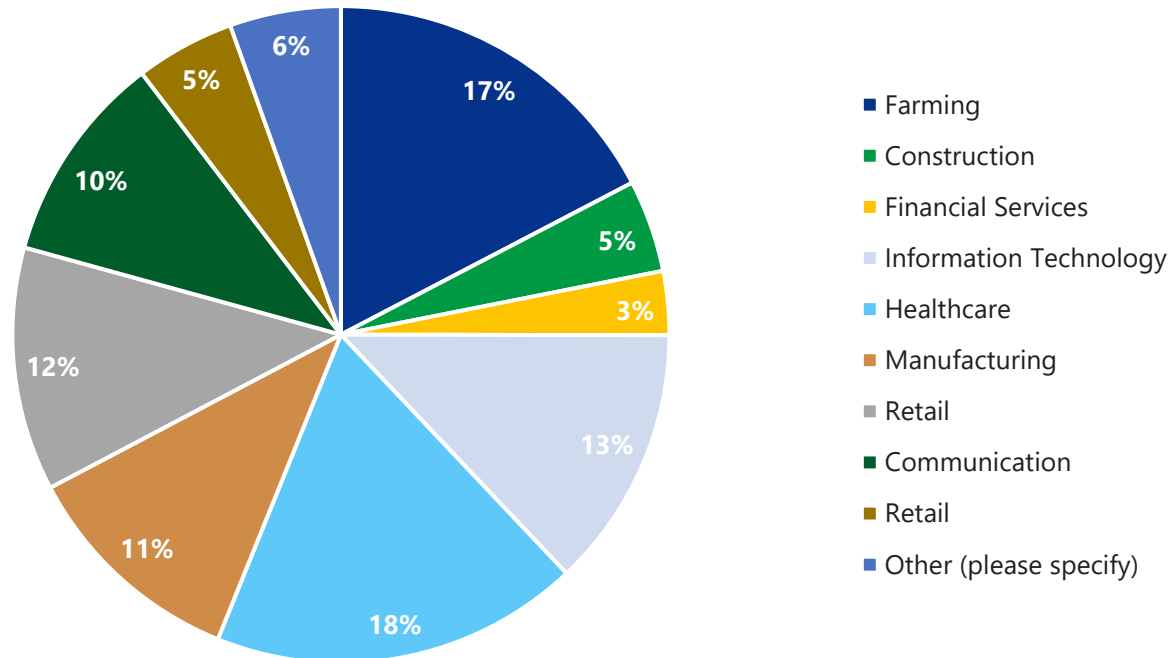


“Very Unimportant” Ranked Resources

The top responses included healthcare (18%) and farming (17%).

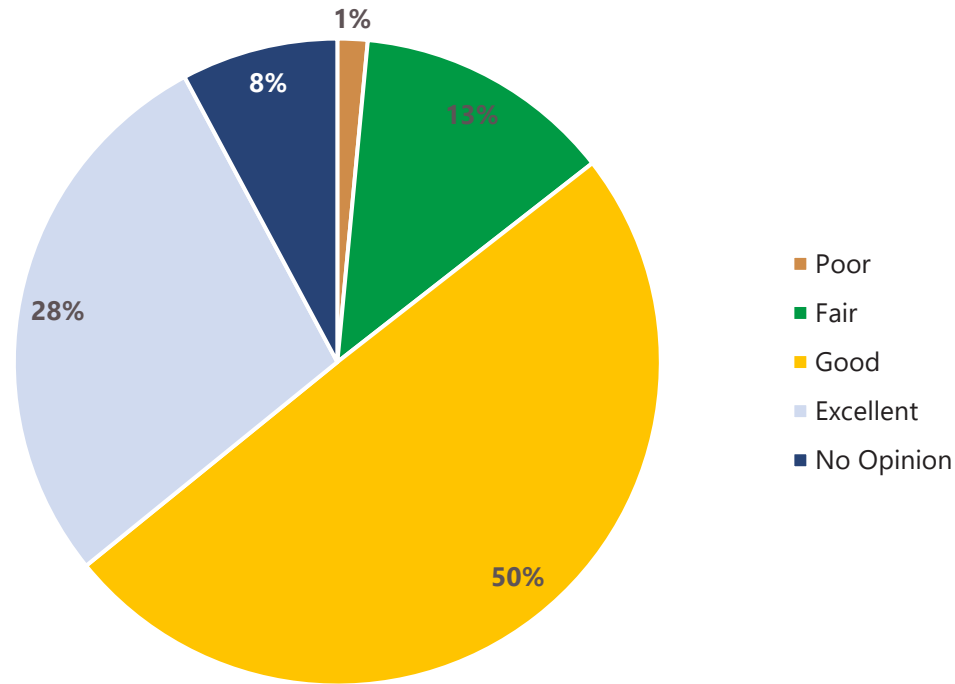

- Organic / sustainable farming

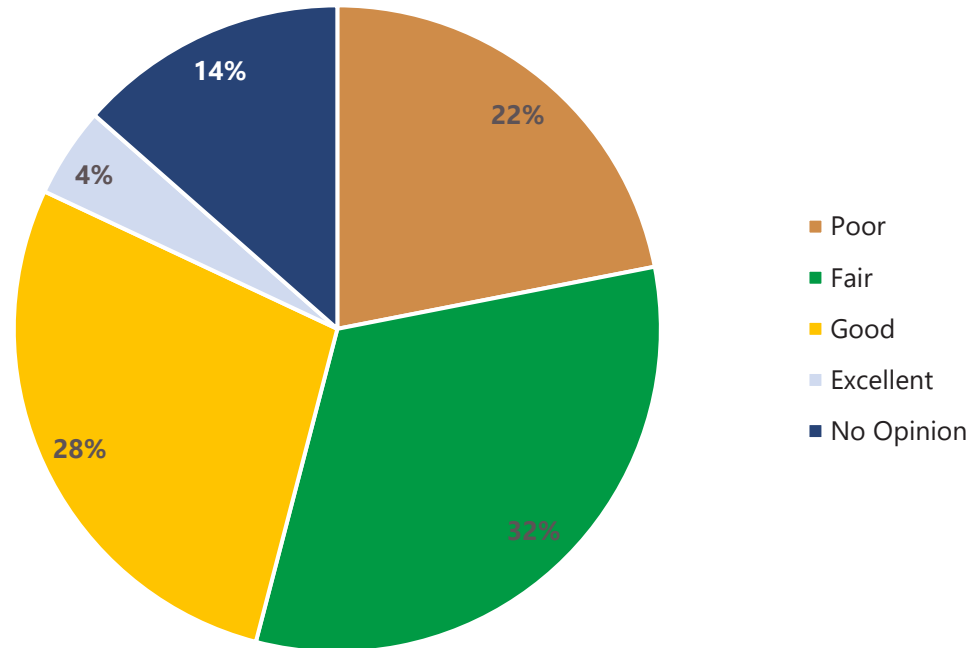

The majority of respondents rated "good" or "excellent" for effectively and efficiently providing essential service.



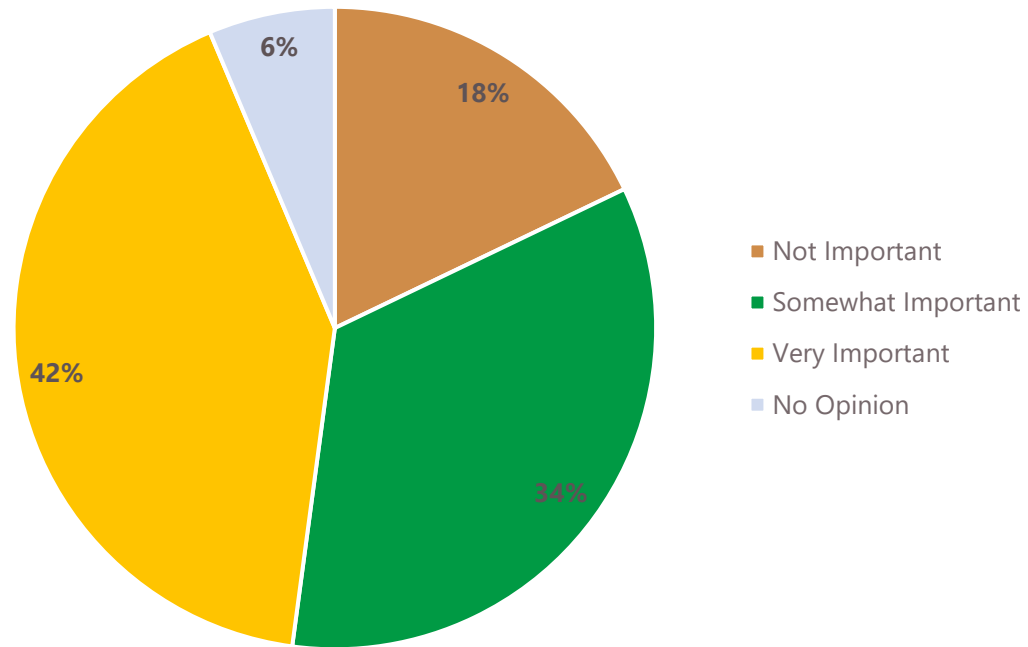
QUESTION 27) HOW WOULD YOU RATE THE COUNTY'S EXISTING TRANSPORTATION NETWORK?

Most responses noted the existing transportation network was "fair" (32%) or "good" (28%).

Most noted "very important" (42%) or "somewhat important" (34%).



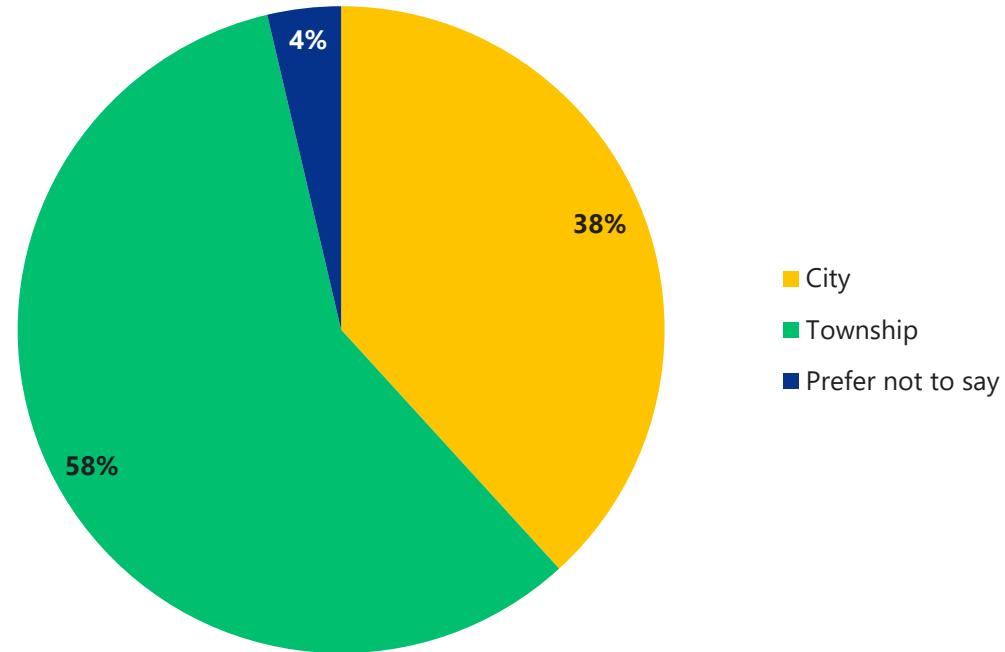

Most comments fell under the following themes:

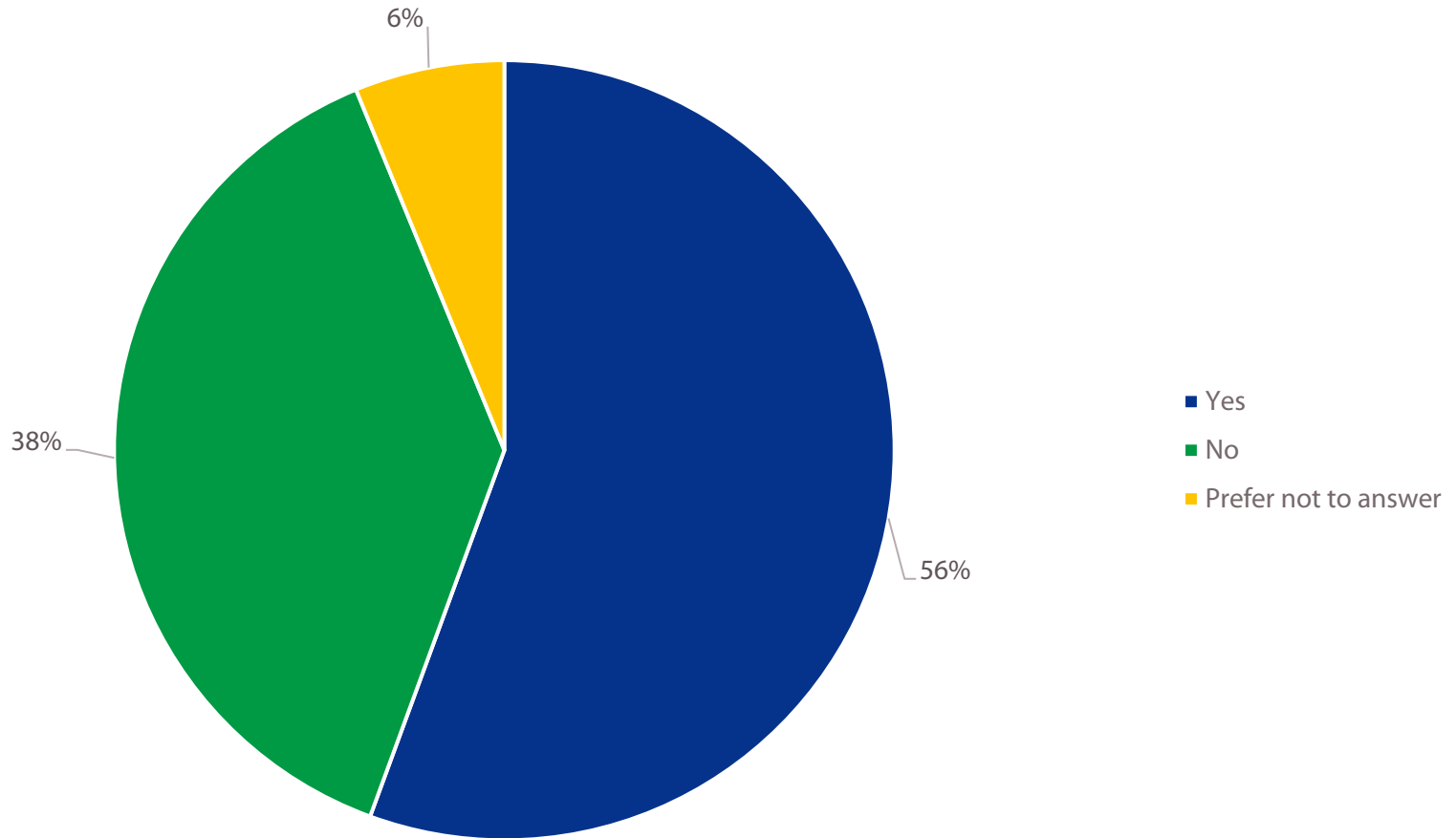
- An urge to slow development in the county, or to be more intentional with development.
 - On the other hand, develop appropriately for the population and projected population growth.
- Similarly, it is a common desire throughout the survey for the county to maintain a small town, rural feel.
- Desire to preserve the farming / agriculture base.
- Expressing a need for a community center / YMCA.
- Strengthen the education system.
- Concerns with the increasing cost of living / high taxes (specifically property taxes).

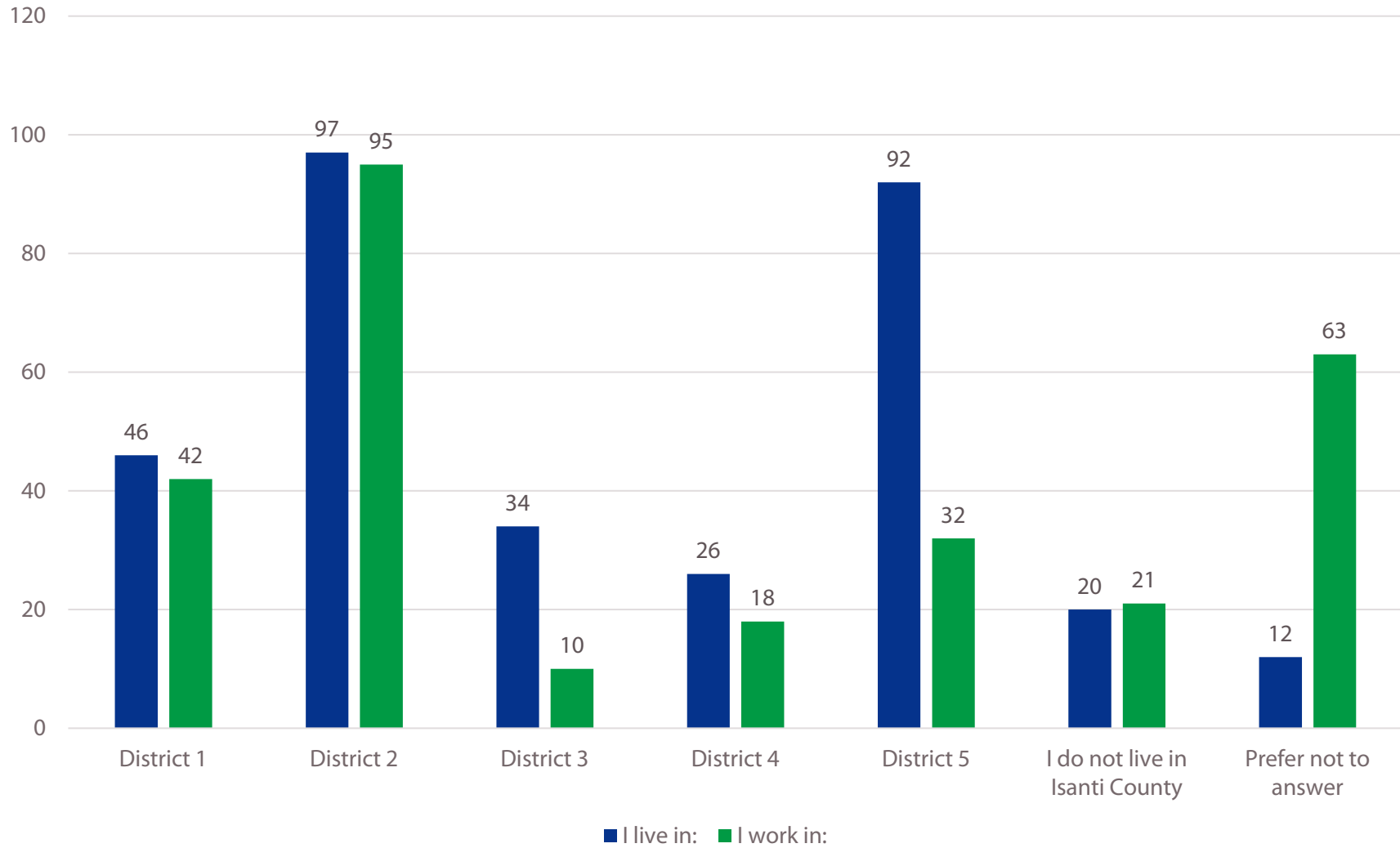


QUESTION 31) DO YOU WORK IN ISANTI COUNTY?

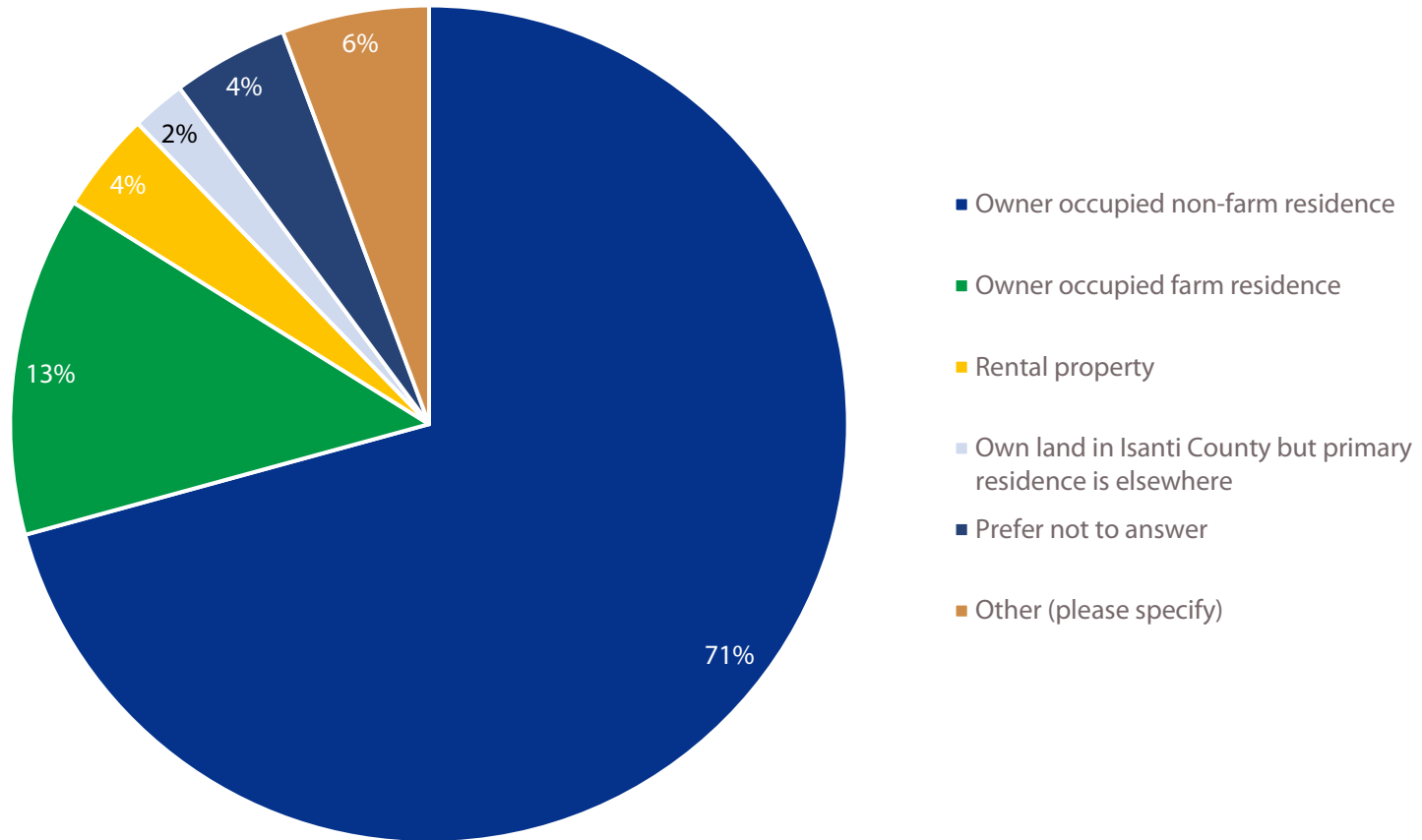


QUESTION 32) WHICH AREA OF ISANTI COUNTY DO YOU LIVE IN?

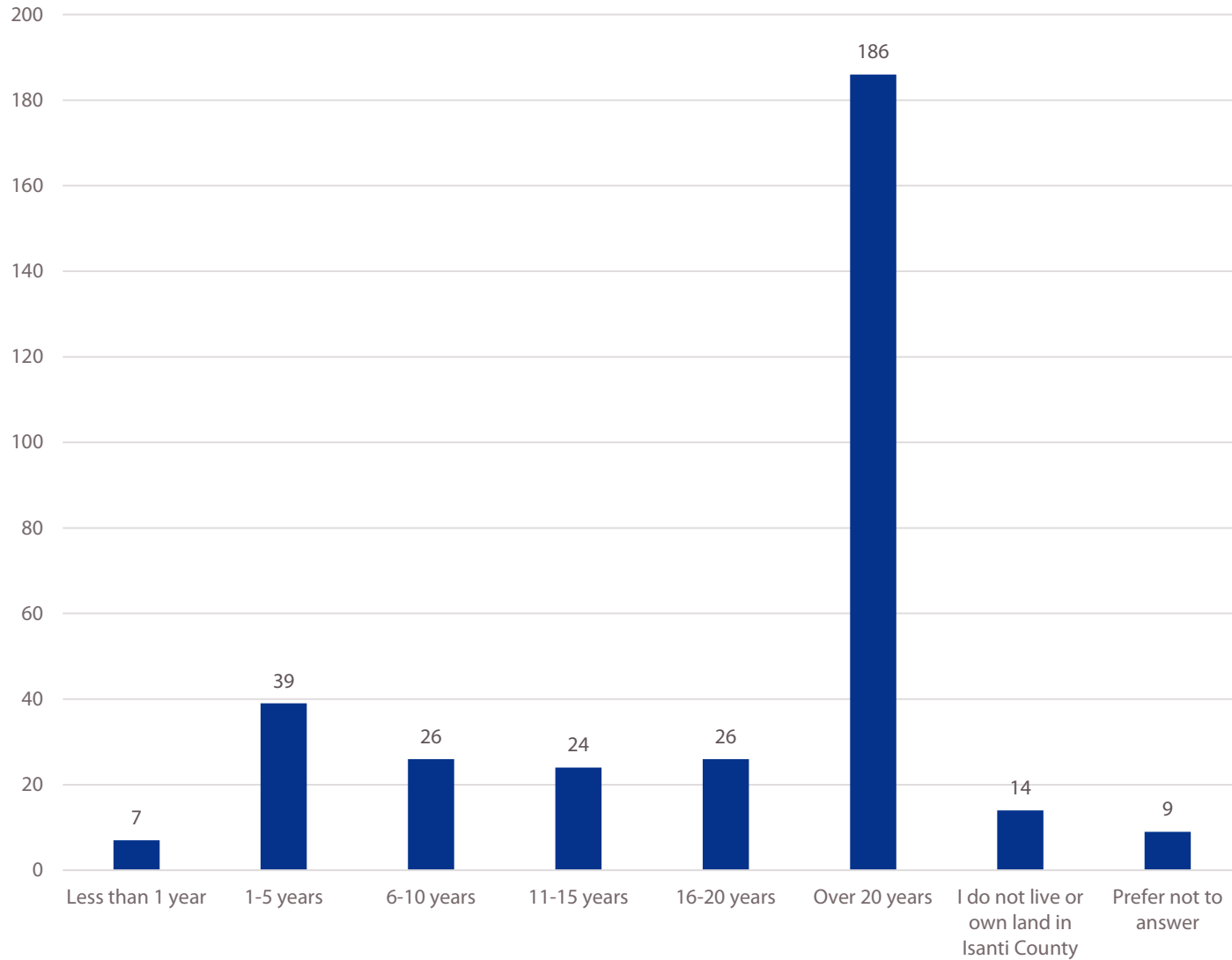
QUESTION 33) WHICH AREA OF ISANTI COUNTY DO YOU WORK IN?



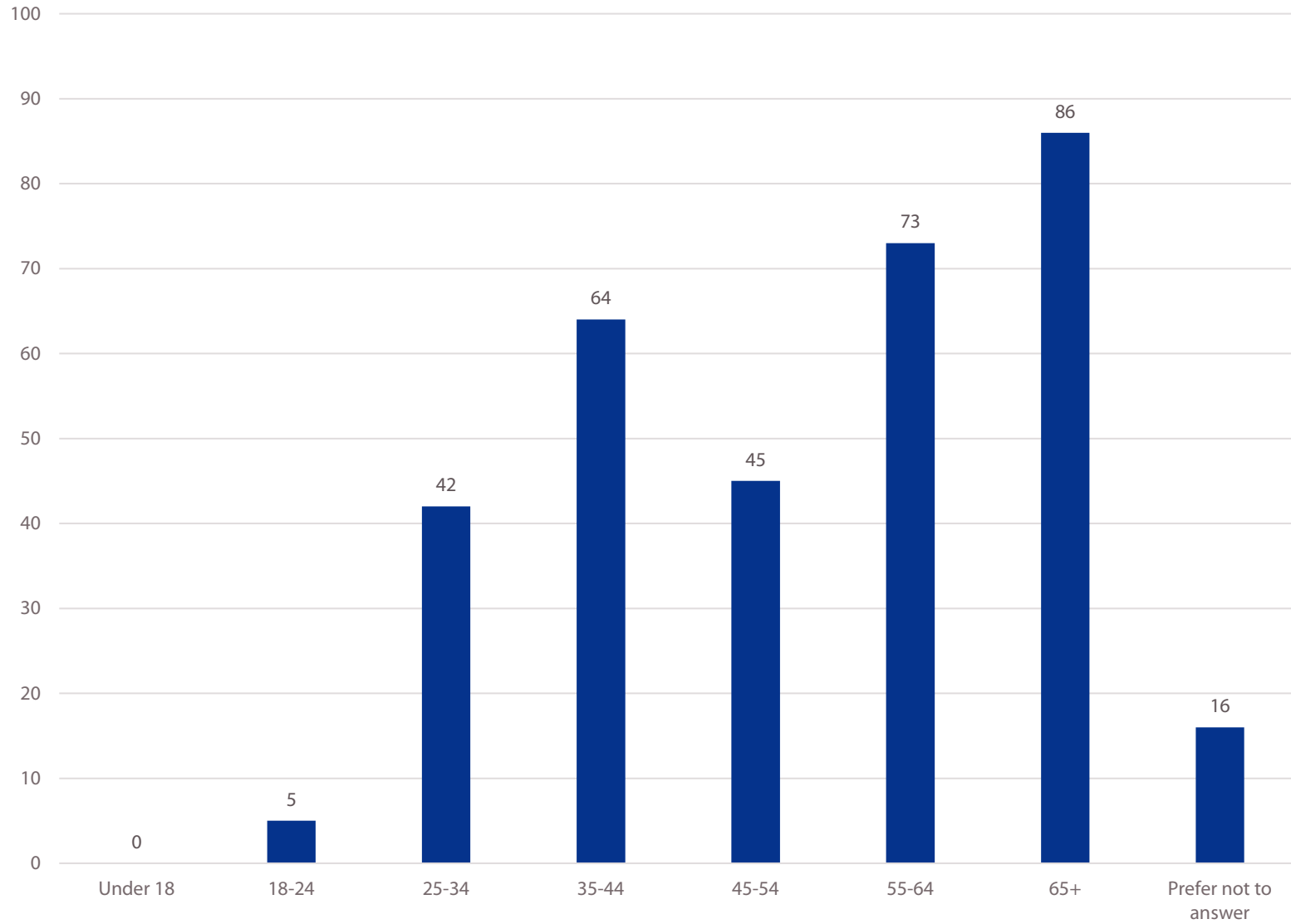
QUESTION 34) WHAT BEST DESCRIBES YOUR PRIMARY PLACE OF RESIDENCE IN ISANTI COUNTY?



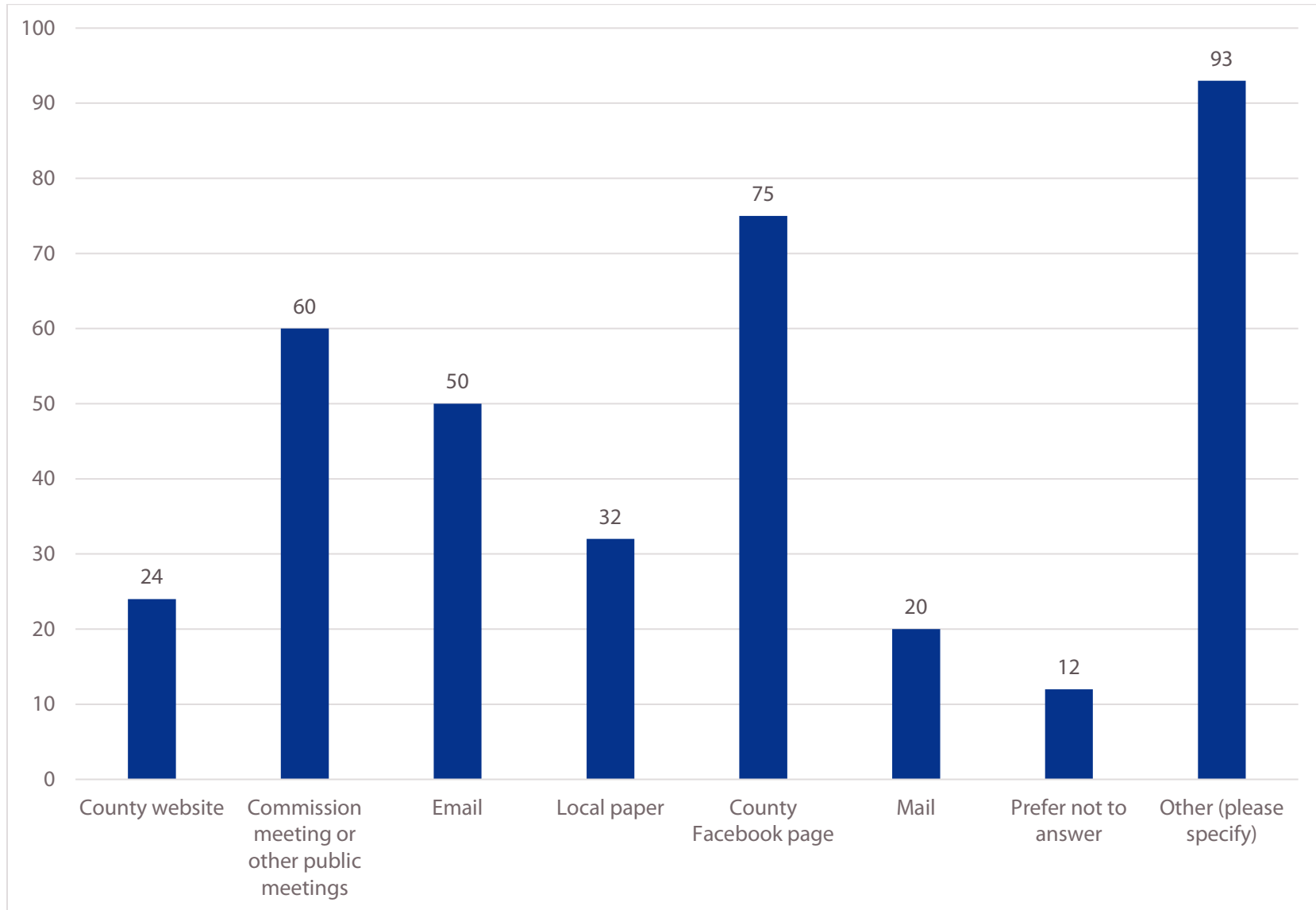
QUESTION 35) HOW LONG HAVE YOU LIVED OR OWNED LAND IN ISANTI COUNTY?
